WHEREAS, Child Abuse Prevention Month is a time when Franklin County Children Services - which receives thousands of reports of child abuse each year and served more than 32,000 children and their families in 2015- educates the community about the issue of child abuse by hosting a community breakfast; and,

WHEREAS, Franklin County Children Services has partnered with Ohio Children's Trust Fund to promote the Pinwheels for Prevention by displaying blue pinwheels throughout the community and drawing attention to both the harsh realities of child abuse and the hope of changing the lives of children for the better; and,

WHEREAS, this partnership will stress that prevention depends on finding solutions to the underlying problems that cause child abuse, and with the help of local and statewide agencies and organizations, we can prevent child abuse through education, information, help for parents under stress, and successful intervention programs; and,


