

Retrospective Review: There are two programs within this area:

- i) **The Primary Alternative Care and Treatment (PACT) program:** In accordance with federal regulations, when a recipient is identified for misuse of physician and/or pharmacy services, those individuals are proposed for enrollment into the PACT program and are limited to a primary care physician and/or pharmacy.
- ii) **The Breast and Cervical Cancer Project (BCCP):** In conjunction with the Department of Health, eligible women are placed on Medicaid to cover expenses related to the treatment of breast and or cervical cancer.
