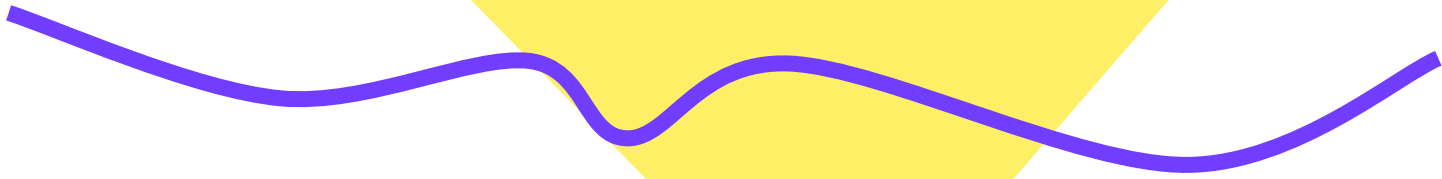




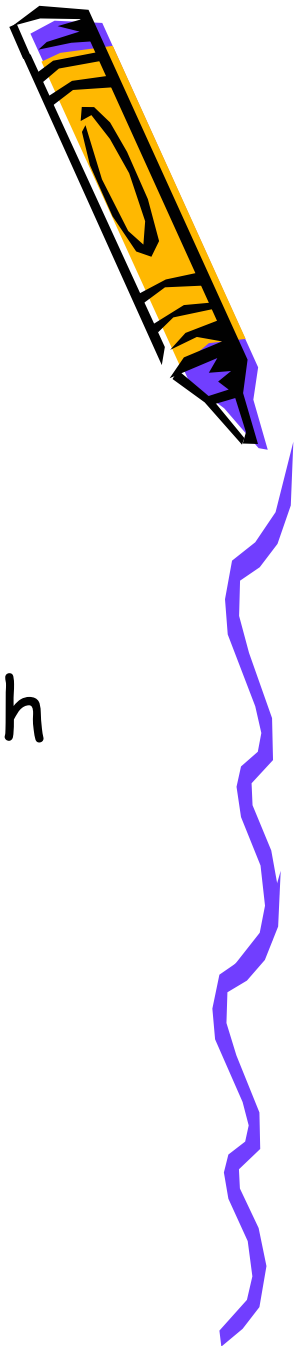
ODJFS Child Health Quality Committee (CHQC)

The CHQC Vision, Mission and Values



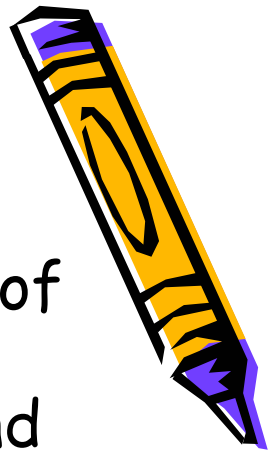
- VISION: Strengthen the health of children served by ODJFS.

Fiscal accountability - Coordinated services



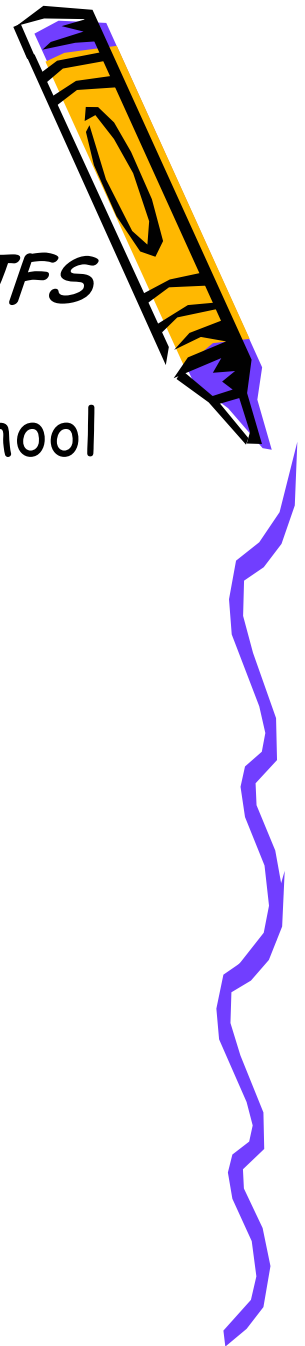
CHQC GOALS:

CHQC will...

- Goal 1: be a catalyst for improving the continuity of care for Ohio's children.
- Goal 2: understand the various funding streams and identify ways to optimize them.
- Goal 3: will identify intra-departmental issues regarding child health and develop means to enhance and support outcomes.
- Goal 4: will see the ongoing commitment of internal stakeholders, and the administration for continued collaborative efforts.
- Goal 5: will identify inter-agency issues regarding child health and develop means to enhance and support external stakeholder outcomes.



The ODJFS Questions on the: CHILD HEALTH CONNECTION #1



Why is child health important to the various ODJFS Offices?

- **Family Stability** -TANF reliance, employment, school absences;
- **Child Support** -Promotes healthy families, establishes and provides medical support;
- **Children and Families** -School readiness, multiple conditions;
- **Fiscal Services** -budget process information;
- **OHP** -High % of Ohio Children on Medicaid, high quality care, preventive care for kids saves \$.



The ODJFS Questions on the: CHILD HEALTH CONNECTION #2



What are the child-related health issues concerning ODJFS?

- **Family Stability** -Compliance with TANF work requirements, job loss;
- **Child Support** -Rising cost of health care, obtaining information, high performance standards;
- **Children and Families** -Accessible services, absenteeism;
- **Fiscal Services** - Fiscal impacts from changes (program & policy).
- **OHP** -Healthchek, Special health care needs, funding.



The ODJFS Questions on the: CHILD HEALTH CONNECTION #3

What are the Offices' current or proposed child health-related initiatives?

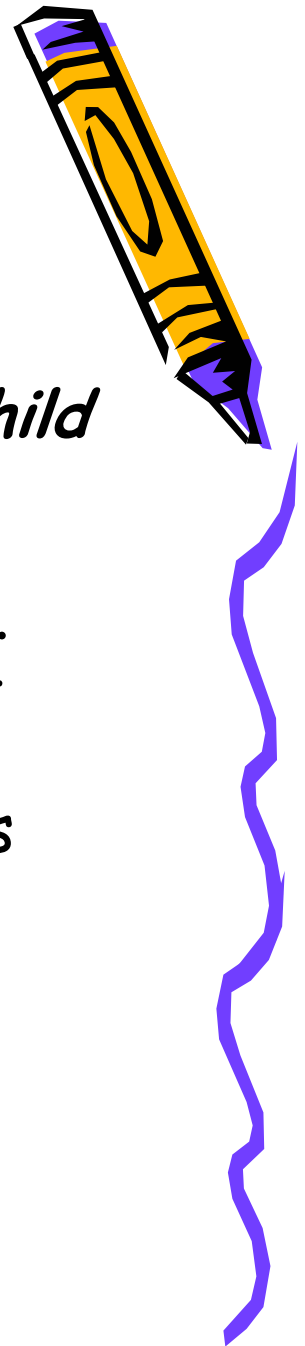
- **Family Stability** -HMG, Ohio Alliance, Children's Hunger Alliance, ABC, LEAP.
- **Child Support** - Performance indicators, matches, affordable premiums, value, reasonable costs.
- **Children and Families** -Special needs, ABC, ELI, ECMH, T-SIG
- **Fiscal Services** -Healthier children...
- **OHP** -CSHCN, MCP, Healthchek, Lead testing, immunizations, dental, mental health, IHBT.



The ODJFS Questions on the: CHILD HEALTH CONNECTION #4

What are the related rules, laws, regulation or policies administered by ODJFS that impact child health?

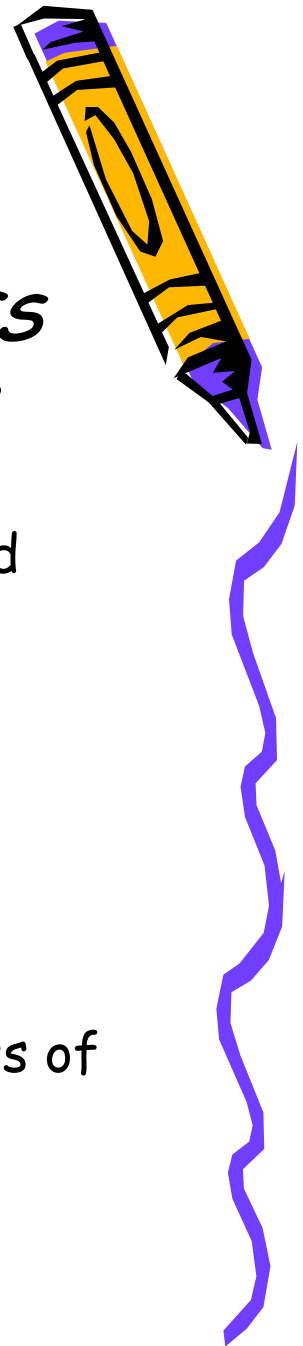
- **Family Stability** - Access to health care, single parent families, work requirements, teen parents.
- **Child Support** - Law requirements in child support orders.
- **Children and Families** - Screenings, special needs care
- **Fiscal Services** - Funds and reporting
- **OHP** - OAC, ORC, MCP, Providers, Inter-agency agreements, CFR.



And Lastly...The ODJFS Questions on the: CHILD HEALTH CONNECTION #5

Why is it important to communicate within ODJFS and coordinate health related services relative child health?

- **Family Stability** -Transitioning efforts, better service, and effectiveness and efficiency.
- **Child Support** -Efficiency and improved data exchange.
- **Children and Families** -Quality of care, decrease fragmentation, and knowledge of initiatives.
- **Fiscal Services** -Fiscal impact and reporting needs.
- **OHP** - Relationship building, promulgation of rules, consideration of needs in policy, and system-wide awareness of available services.
