Independent Living Skills Training

Independent Living Skills Training providers supply the information, resources and educational support individuals need to live independently outside of an institution. The training focuses on financial management skills, social skills, health management skills, home management skills, personal skills and community living skills.

- An Independent Living Skills Training provider must be a non-profit or a community mental health center certified by the Ohio Department of Mental Health (ODMH).
- The agency's staff must have either a disability and have successfully transitioned to the community from an institution or have experience in transitioning individuals from an institution to the community.
- The staff must have knowledge of community resources and the applicable disability laws and regulations.
- In order to supply services as an Independent Living Skills Training provider, the agency must submit a HOME Choice Provider Application and Agreement. The application and provider agreement can be obtained on-line at <http://jfs.ohio.gov/ohp/consumers/homechoice.stm> or by calling 1-888-221-1560.
- In order to submit a claim for reimbursement, the Independent Living Skills Training provider must be identified on the consumer's HOME Choice Demonstration Program service plan.
- The service must be provided one-on-one, in a group setting for up to three people, or in a classroom setting for more than four.
- The training must not duplicate the Community Support Coaching Services that are available through the HOME Choice Demonstration Program.
- Providers must agree to meet the Conditions of Participation set forth in Ohio Revised Code (OAC) rule 5101-3-51-05.
