**RA for provider types 16, 17, 18, 25, 38, 45 and 60**

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) Bureau of Home and Community Services (BHCS) has revised the JFS 02374 "Private Duty Nursing Services Request" and the JFS 02219 "Affidavit of Tax Payment Compliance for Non-Agency-Employed ODJFS-Administered Waiver Service Providers" in order to add space for Medicaid providers' new National Provider Identifier (NPI). By federal mandate, the NPI became the standard number used to identify Medicaid providers on May 23, 2007.

Space will still be provided on the JFS 02374 and the JFS 02219 for current Medicaid legacy provider numbers; however, all providers must also include their new NPI when completing these forms.

No other changes are being made to these forms at this time.
