

### Overview: U277 from MITS

The U277 which is generated from MITS is slightly different from the U277 which was returned from MMIS. The U277 is now generated after the claims adjudication process. It has additional information which provides the status of the claim.

When the claim is adjudicated in MITS, ODJFS will generate an ICN (Interchange control Number) which is returned in the REF\*1K\*ICN~ segment of the U277.

The STC01 -1 segment indicates the overall status of the claim. A2 (Accepted) will be returned if the claim is paid partial or in full or A7 (rejected) if the entire claim is denied. For instance when a claim is partially accepted; if a claim has 10 lines and ODJFS paid 5 lines but denied the other 5 lines, the claim at the header level will be paid (A2) for all 10 lines. For each line ODJFS will send back an STC segment with an A2: and a HIPAA status code. For the 5 lines which were denied there will be a status of A2 with a denied HIPAA status code.

If a claim is completely paid; if a claim has 10 lines and all 10 lines were paid the U277 will have a status of A2:20 which mean that whole claim is accepted. There will be no additional STC segments to report each line status.

If a claim is completely denied; if a claim has 10 lines and all 10 lines were denied the U277 will have a status of A7: with a denied status code. Each line will have an STC segment with the appropriate denied status code.

- Region status which has the P-Paid, D-Denied, S-suspended(waiting for manual intervention), X-super suspend(claim problem cannot process)
