E	Establishes data from the results oriented management (ROM) and business intelligence channel (BIC) can be utilized during the evaluation, reconciliation and quality improvement processes.	May impact internal PCSA processes if these data systems were not previously utilized by the PCSA.
G	Clarifies the process to appeal the CPOE final report if a PCSA disputes one or more of the CPOE findings and is requesting a decision by ODJFS to change the CPOE report or its findings.	This is not a new requirement; however, language was clarified to more accurately reflect the appeal process.
I	Establishes the PCSA may request the assistance of ODJFS in developing a quality improvement plan (QIP) or to provide technical assistance in the implementation of the plan.	This is not a new requirement; however, language was added to reflect the availability of support to the PCSA from ODJFS.
J	Clarifies the decision to grant an extension to submit a QIP will be provided within 15 days. Also, clarifies the length of the extension will be based on the rationale provided for the extension.	This is not a new requirement; however, language was added to reflect the current process when a PCSA requests an extension to submit a QIP.
