
Placement distribution




















Key Commentary

in Placement Snapshot




- The number of children in Placement has decreased to a more manageable level, however is being monitored as it appears to be increasing
- The 12 month high of children in Placement is 433
- April 2016 the number of placements increased 22 over the previous month

In-County vs. Out of County



- Over the course of the last 12 months, significant progress has been made in ensuring more Placements occur within Butler County instead of other distanced Counties. April had an increase in Placements, the majority of which are placed “In County”

Length of Stay in Care



- Length of stay in care category of “36 months or longer” is at a 12 month high of 101. The average of the last 12 months is 90.
