<p>Outcome B1) Early care and education programs achieve higher levels of quality to increase the supply of high quality programs so children have experiences that support their optimal development and learning.</p> <p>Performance Indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligible programs as defined by ODJFS are assigned a single point of contact that oversees the initial assessment(s), the development of the quality improvement plan, coordination of specialists/services and ongoing communication of progress; • Increase the number of Two Star rated programs and support Emerging Stars so they can become Star rated as a result of consultative coaching/mentoring; and • Specialists meet qualifications and performance requirements as set forth by OCCRRA on behalf of ODJFS upon hire and throughout employment. <p>Quality Assurance Measure(s): Monthly report that has number of programs by county, ODJFS license number, entry date, number of monthly contact hours by assigned staff person, assessment data and any other data as requested by ODJFS.</p> <p>Unit Funding includes: The provision of any and all services necessary to meet the performance indicators listed above. Units equal to the level of effort (low, medium, high) by program per month.</p>	<p>Outcome B2) Families receive enhanced resource and referral services to increase demand for quality early care and education options so their children can have the experiences that support their optimal development and learning.</p> <p>Performance Indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligible at risk families as defined by ODJFS (such as child welfare, dual language learners, disabilities/special health conditions, military, homeless) assigned a counselor to assist them with the development of a plan to support their goals. <p>Quality Assurance Measure: Quarterly report documenting the number/percent of families connected to quality early care and education services as a result of the enhanced consultation.</p> <p>Unit Funding includes: The provision of any and all services necessary to meet the performance indicators listed above. Units equal the number of family plans developed/updated per month.</p>	<p>Outcome B3) Community stakeholders (community members, businesses, industries, schools, public agencies, faith communities, and other community organizations) implement a community quality improvement plan to increase the number of high quality early care and education programs in their service delivery area.</p> <p>Performance Indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Convene key stakeholders to increase public and private support for systems building efforts; and • Participate in and collaborate with policy making groups to support systems building efforts. <p>Quality Assurance Measure: Quarterly report documenting summary of systems building progress with goals for next quarter.</p> <p>Unit Funding includes: The provision of any and all services necessary to meet the performance indicators listed above. Units equal the number of action steps met on the community quality improvement plan per quarter.</p>
