NOTICE OF APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY

This Committee will accept applications for apprenticeship Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. at the I.B.E.W. Hall located at 5805 Frazeyburg Road, Nashport (Rt. 60 N - 3 miles north of Zanesville).

All applications must fully meet the following minimum qualifications to qualify for an interview:

1. Must be at least 18 years of age. (Copy of birth certificate required when applying.)
2. Must be a high school graduate or have GED. (Bring copy of diploma when applying.)
3. Minimum math - must have completed one full year of high school Algebra I with a passing grade or one post high school algebra course with a passing grade. **Must provide official transcript or transcripts for high school and post high school showing courses and grades when applying.**
4. Must present or sign a statement that he or she is physically able to perform electrical construction work. Applicants selected from the pool may be required to provide results of a physical examination and a drug test if the Committee elects.
5. Must be a resident of the following counties or townships: Coshocton, Guernsey, Licking, Perry, Muskingum counties or Jackson, Clay, Morgan, Miller, Milford, Hilliard, Butler, Harrison, Pleasant and College townships in Knox County or Auburn, York, Jefferson, Clay, Rush, Oxford, Perry, Washington, Salem and Buck townships in Tuscarawas County.
6. Must have a valid driver's license.

Each applicant who meets all basic requirements will be eligible for an interview by the Committee whenever an interview date has been arranged. The interviews will consider: reliability, interest, attitude, judgment, cooperativeness, as well as other personal traits. All applications will be received without regard to race, color, religion, national origin or sex. Each applicant must meet all basic requirements to be eligible for an interview. Apprentices will be selected in order of their ranking resulting from rating of interviewers.

ELECTRICAL APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY

Below is a list of questions you may have in regard to your application to the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee for the Electrical Contracting Industry.

WHAT DO I NEED WITH MY APPLICATION? You must provide a copy of your Birth Certificate, High School Diploma or GED, Official High School Grade Transcript and Official College High School Transcripts.

WHEN MUST THESE PAPERS BE SUBMITTED? Applications will be accepted Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. and from 12:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m.

WHAT ARE THE BASIC QUALIFICATIONS? You must be at least 18 years of age. You must be a high school graduate or have a GED. You must have completed one full year of high school algebra course with a passing grade or one post high school algebra course with a passing grade. You must be a resident of the Local Union areas which consists of the following counties and townships: Coshocton, Guernsey, Licking, Perry and Muskingum counties or Jackson, Clay, Morgan, Miller, Milford, Hilliard, Butler, Harrison, Pleasant and College Townships in Knox county or Auburn, York, Jefferson, Clay, Rush, Oxford, Washington, Salem, Perry, and Buck Townships in Tuscarawas county.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT IF I GET TO THIS POINT? From all the applications taken, those who meet all qualifications will be asked to return to be interviewed and ranked by the Apprenticeship Committee. Those with the best ranking will be selected. You will be notified by mail periodically of your progress in the selections procedure.

IF SELECTED, WHEN WILL I GO TO WORK? As soon thereafter as a job becomes available.

WHERE WILL I GO TO WORK? Wherever work is available within the seven counties listed above.

WHAT WILL MY WAGES BE? You will start at 40% of the Journeyman Wireman's wages. This is increased on a percentage basis as you progress.

HOW LONG WILL I BE AN APPRENTICE? The term of Apprenticeship is 8000 on-the-job hours training. You will attend classes at least 208 hours per year for five (5) years.

WHAT KIND OF WORK WILL I BE DOING? All kinds of electrical work, but mostly building construction.
