## NOTICE OF YEAR-ROUND APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 1997

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The Lorain County Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee of I.B.E.W. Local Union No. 129 will be accepting applications for openings in the Apprenticeship Program every **FIRST** and **THIRD** "working" Wednesday of the month from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Applications will be taken at the IBEW Local Union No. 129 office located at 105 Cooper Foster Park road-West, Lorain. You must apply in person (no applications can be taken home) on the days and times stated above.

At the time of application applicants must fully meet the following minimum qualifications:

1. AGE – At least 18 years old.
2. RESIDENT – of Lorain, Erie or Huron County
3. EDUCATION – High School graduate. (GED acceptable)
4. ALGEBRA – One year of high school Algebra or one post High School Algebra course completed with a passing Grade, GED Algebra is NOT acceptable.

Each applicant **MUST FURNISH** copies of the following at the time of application: Birth Certificate, High School transcripts (not diploma), GED Certificate and College transcript if applicable. Applicants are required to pay a \$25.00 non-refundable Application fee. Check or money order only: Make checks or money order payable to "Lorain JATC". ALL DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE LORAIN JATC AND WILL NOT BE RETURNED TO THE APPLICANT. WE DO NOT MAKE COPIES.

Each applicant who meets all basic requirements and provides the Committee with all the documents requested will be interviewed by the Committee on an as needed basis. Interviewers will consider reliability, interest, attitude, judgment and cooperativeness as well as other personal traits. Apprentices will be selected in order of ranking resulting from the interview ratings, all others will be placed on a two year eligibility list.

All applications will be reviewed without regard to race, color, religion, national origin or sex.
