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Articulation Agreements

- What are they?
 - Agreements designed to provide college credit for training not provided by an accredited institution.
 - Provide avenues for advancing education to higher levels beyond Journey person's certificate.



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Articulation Agreements

- How do they work?
 - Course work is reviewed to determine what credit, if any, can be granted.
 - Meet with Committee when requested.
 - Cover requirements for maintaining MOU.
 - Complete documentation, i.e. instructors, registrations, grades...



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WHERE WILL THE COLLEGE CREDITS APPLY?

- Associates of Applied Science Degree
- Various Certificates
- Transferable to other institutions

- Students have access to entire campus services.

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What About Journeypersons?

- Associate of Technical Studies
- College credit granted for having completed registered apprenticeship program.
- Approximately 1/2 of degree completed.
- Minimum of 30 credit hours to complete degree.



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Associate of Technical Studies Type “B”

- Technical credit completed through apprenticeship.
- General & basic education credits need completed.
- Minimum of 30 additional credits in general education classes required.
- Can be completed without coming to the campus.



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How To Get Started

- Apprentice Coordinator and College representative meet to discuss what is possible.
- Discuss with Apprentice Committee
- Have Institution & Committee Meet to discuss MOU
- Develop Partnership
