

JFS 01279 Communicable Disease Curriculum for Child Care Participant Manual-2009 Revisions

Infection-How Diseases are Spread:

Pg 4- Two graphics (Droplet/Respiratory Diseases and Fecal/Oral Diseases) were moved to the power point presentation

Employee Safety:

Page 5- Clarified that the term “standard precautions” is “basic” precautions in ODJFS Child Care Rules. Both terms refer to the same precautions.

Pg 6 and 7- Clarified that hepatitis B requirements are in OSHA rules, not ODJFS Child Care rules

Page 7- Added links to the CDC Web site about hepatitis B and vaccine guidelines

Prevention and Control of Diseases in Child Care:

Pg 8- Discussed the information required for the Child Enrollment Health Information form

Immunization and Health History for Child Care Staff:

All immunization schedules and immunization information updated

Pg 9- Updated health requirements for child care staff

Pg 12- Added the CDC immunization schedule to this section of the manual and added the link to the current CDC immunization schedules on the CDC Web site.

Pg 13- Added information on Healthy Children and Healthy Families Programs to educate child care staff about both insurance programs

Health Risks for Pregnant Staff:

Pg 14- Expanded this section with more specific information for child care staff about diseases that are risks for pregnant workers

Environmental Control Measures:

Pg 16- Made hand washing section match the revised rules about hand washing

Pg 17- Added that antibacterial soap should not be used and rationale for this.

Pg 18- Added the hand washing chart to this section

Pg 20- Added the diapering chart to this section

Pg 23- Updated the section "Industrial Products" to match the revised rules about the use of industrial products for sanitation and/or disinfection
- Added note about what type of industrial product is appropriate for cleaning blood or blood-tinged body fluids

Pg 23-28- Updated the information on these pages and chart "Schedule for Cleaning and Sanitizing Items" to match the revised rules

Pg 29- Revised bullet number 7 and 8 to match revised rules about toothbrush use and handling

Page 30-33- Updated infant feeding guidelines to match revised rules

Care of the Well and Ill Child:

Pg 33- Added a group separation chart to help explain this rule

Pg 34- Added that the only method for temperature taking is the axillary method and explained the rationale. Stressed the importance of not adding or subtracting a degree to the reading. Use the actual axillary temperature reading when determining whether a child should be sent home.

Pg 35- Staff and Child Readmittance Criteria- updated to match the ODH Infectious Disease Control Manual (IDCM)

Pg 39-40- Added that an Incident/Injury Report must be submitted when a medication error occurs.

Pg 40- Added a link to the ODH website for the document *Know Your ABCs: A Quick Guide to Reportable Infectious Diseases*

Pg 41- Added a list of steps to prepare the child care setting for a disaster or emergency

Pg 41- Updated list of web sites for disaster planning. Added a paragraph about first aid kits and provided the link to the rule where the list of required contents can be found

Pg 42- Updated this section of the manual to reflect all rule revisions
