

# **Work Requirement (JOBS) Reports**

**January 1, 2006 - June 30, 2006**

These five reports summarize Work Requirement activities from January 1, 2006 through June 30, 2006. The first five reports cover both OWF Work Requirement and the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program (FSET). Some OWF data are also showed for both Single Parent OWF (ADC regular and ADC for families with an incapacitated member), and Two Parent OWF (ADC-U unemployed parent). The fifth report, Monthly Participation Rate, does not cover recipients who only registered in the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program (FSET).

### **1. Monthly Participation Rates by County**

This county break-out is for selected data from the Monthly Participation Rates Report. This report does not include recipients who are solely registered in the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program (FSET).

*Note: State participation rates do not necessarily agree with those published by Administration for Children and Families (ACF). ACF rates are calculated from a sample of cases. Final rates for federal fiscal year 2006 are not yet available.*

### **2. Work Requirement Participation Data by County**

All figures on this report are the *average monthly* number of participants for the six-month period.

#### **Participation Status**

*Universe:* The universe is Count of Individuals Exempt From Participation, Under Sanction, and Total Required and Voluntary.

*Exempt From Participation:* These individuals are not required to participate in Work Requirement for the reasons indicated on the first table. Not all OWF exemptions apply to the Food Stamp Program.

### **3. Work Requirement Employment Report**

All figures reflect the average number of individuals who entered employment during the six month period.

*Total Entering Employment:* This is the total of individuals who began new employment during the reporting period. All other line items on this report are included within the total. The total is based on employments entered on the Work Requirement Sub-System and the Benefit Issuance Sub-System.

*Part-time Hours:* A part-time job is defined as less than 30 hours per week.

*Full-time Hours:* A full-time job is defined as 30 or more hours per week.

*Hours Unknown:* Hours of employment are unknown for people reported on the Benefit Issuance Sub-System.

*Wages:* Wages are unknown for people reported on the Benefit Issuance Sub-System.

*Annual Income:* Calculated from wage and hours. Unknown includes all those not reported by Work Requirement.

**4. Demographics Report for Work Requirement Participants with Full-time or Part-time Employment**

This report shows the demographic characteristics of individuals entering employment. This is the same population covered by Work Requirement Employment Report.

**5. Work Requirement Employment Report by County**

This county break-out is a cumulative number of individuals entering employment during the reporting period.
