Work Requirement Report

January 1, 2010 - June 30, 2010

Work Requirement Report

This report includes data on the number of OWF assistance groups (AGs) in each county that were required to participate in work activities in each month of the reporting period. It shows both the number of AGs required to work and the number that did work. The “All Family” data in the report includes all work-required OWF AGs; the “Two Parent” data is a subset of this information, including only those AGs headed by two parents. Both state and federal participation rates are shown for the “All Family” data.

1. Monthly Participation Rates

This county break-out provides a total of AGs for each month of the six month period of the report. It does include OWF work-required AGs, but does not include recipients who are registered only in the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program (FSET).

2. Work Requirement Participation Data by County

All figures represent the average monthly number of participants for the six month period of the report. The report includes averages for each county of all individuals required to participate in work activities, individuals who are not required to participate in work activities but who do so voluntarily, and individuals who are exempt from work requirements and are not participating in work activities. Also included is an unduplicated total of both required and voluntary participants in work activities for the reporting period. Both OWF and FSET participants are included; not all OWF exemptions apply to the food stamp program.

3. Work Requirement Employment Report

All figures reflect the total number of individuals who entered employment during the six month period of the report. Both OWF and FSET participants are included.

Total Entering Employment: This is the total number of individuals who began new employment during the reporting period. All other line items on the report are a subset of this total.

Part-Time Hours: Defined as less than 30 hours per week.

Full-Time Hours: Defined as 30 or more hours per week.

Wages: Wages are reported on an hourly basis.

Annual Income: Calculated from wage and hours; cannot be calculated for individuals whose information in these categories is not known.

4. Demographics Report for Work Requirement Participants with Full-time or Part-time Employment

This report shows the demographic characteristics of individuals entering employment. This is the same population covered by the Work Requirement Employment Report.

5. Work Requirement Employment Report by County

This county break-out is a cumulative number of individuals entering employment during the reporting period. Both OWF and FSET participants are included.
