Child Support Enforcement Report

Overview

Federal Child Support requirements require Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) IV-D program performance to be reported in the performance measures of:

Establishment of Paternity

Establishment of Support Orders

Collection of Current Support

Collection of Past Due Support

The data is reported on the State OCSE 157/ODJFS4223 Report (QFR094RA). The report is generated quarterly, with a final Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) report submitted to the federal office. Performance line item data is measured either as it occurred during the reporting period or as a point in time measure. The data contained in this report is broken into six month calendar year periods, and is representative of the applicable point in time of the federal reporting period. The January – June report reflects months four through nine of the federal reporting period. The July – December report reflects the last three and first three months of two separate FFY reporting periods.

Performance Measurements

The attached performance measure summary details Ohio's counties performance percentages for the period of July, 2011 through December, 2011.

- ◆ Establishment of Paternity – County performance is measured using the IV-D paternity establishment percentage (IV-D PEP) - calculated by dividing the total number of children born out of wedlock with paternity established or acknowledged in IV-D cases during the performance year by the total number of children born out of wedlock in IV-D cases open as of the end of the preceding performance year. The IV-D PEP measurement is reflected in this report.

Ohio's performance is measured using the state-wide paternity establishment percentage (PEP) - calculated by dividing the number of Ohio children having paternity established for the current year, divided by the number of Ohio children born out-of-wedlock during the previous year.

- ◆ Establishment of Support Orders – calculated by dividing the number of IV-D cases open at the end of the reporting period with support orders established by the total number of IV-D cases open at the end of the period.
- ◆ Collection of Current Support – calculated by dividing the total amount of current support distributed in IV-D cases during the fiscal year by the total amount of current support due in IV-D cases for the fiscal year.

Collection of Past Due Support – calculated by dividing the number of IV-D cases paying toward arrearages during the reporting period by the total number of IV-D cases with arrears due during the reporting period.
