

## Title IV-E Cost Reports - Interim Period Filings

The standard reporting period for the Title IV-E cost report is the state fiscal year of July 1 through June 30. However, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 5101:2-47-26.1(F), PCSAs, PCPAs, or PNAs new to the Title IV-E program or existing PCSAs, PCPAs, or PNAs that have established a new Title IV-E service must submit a JFS 02911 for a minimum of three full calendar months of operations in order to receive a Title IV-E reimbursement ceiling amount.

In lieu of the agreed-upon procedures report, filers must submit specific backup documentation which supports their reported expenses and census count for the interim reporting period. A desk review is performed by the Office of Families and Children. Once the desk review is finalized, information is updated on the applicable Title IV-E reimbursement ceilings link at the following website: <http://ifs.ohio.gov/ocf/publications.stm>. Approved Title IV-E reimbursement ceilings are typically effective retroactively to the initial date of child placement in the new service/program.
