IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT CHANGES IN FRAUDULENT RECEIPT OF OWF RULES

Our records show that you are getting Ohio works First (OWF) payments for some family members but not for yourself. You are not getting OWF for yourself because the County Department of Job and Family Services (CDJFS) determined that you committed fraud and got OWF that you should not have gotten. You cannot get OWF for yourself until you have repaid the entire amount to the CDJFS.

Under the new rules, after December 31, 2006, you will not be able to get any OWF for family members until you have repaid.

Contact your CDJFS worker to find out what you need to do.

If the CDJFS determines that you have repaid, you may be able to start getting OWF for yourself and family members again.

If the CDJFS determines that you have not repaid by December 3.1 st, the CDJFS will stop OWF for family members. The CDJFS will send you another Important Notice explaining its decision and your appeal rights. You may be able to start getting OWF for yourself and family members again after the CDJFS determines that you have repaid.

The new rules go into effect on September 29, 2006.

Note: If there are two parents in your family, and both parents are being sanctioned by the CDJFS, then both sanctioned parents must comply in order to keep getting OWF for family members.
