SUBJECT: SPRING FLOOD 2004: ADDITIONAL COUNTIES ADDED

We recently announced the availability of funds for disaster assistance for families and individuals who have been adversely affected by the recent severe weather conditions. Please refer to Office of Family Stability Letter (OFSL) #18, dated May 21, 2004.

Since the issuance of the letter, the Governor has declared Hocking, Mahoning and Portage County to be in a state of emergency as a result of the recent flooding. This brings the total number of counties to eleven. The counties affected are Athens, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Hocking, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Noble, Perry, Portage and Summit. Other counties may be added at a later date, if or when declared by the Governor to be in a state of emergency.

Please reference the Office of Family Stability Letter (OFSL) #18 for eligibility requirements, the maximum amount of funds that will be available to each county and the funding and fiscal coding procedures.

The Spring Flood 2004 Program in Hocking, Mahoning and Portage County will begin **Friday June 18, 2004** and run through close of business on **Friday July 16, 2004**.
