Topic: Income Maintenance as Child Support Match

Changes to Ohio Administrative Code 5101:9-6-05 provides authority for a CDJFS to transfer all or a portion of its Income Maintenance (IM) allocation to the CSEA to assist in meeting Title IV-D program match requirements.

This BCFTA update provides coding for county agencies that choose to transfer any portion of their IM allocation to the CSEA. A CSEA may use the allocation to cover ceiling excess for State Match.

In order to ensure that the transferred funding is spent on allowable activities, the amount of IM transferred from the Public Assistance fund to the Child Support must be equal to or less than the amount of State Match ceiling excess.
