CSEA Performance Incentives

Due to delays in finalizing the state fiscal year 2010/2011 biennial budget, the monthly performance incentives (1/12th of calendar year 2009 issuance) for July and August will be disbursed to child support agencies next week.

SSRMS Reconcile

This is just a reminder that the SSRMS Reconcile process is now part of your QuIC+ system and the final upload is due to BCFTA by **August 24, 2009.**

Maximus provided training on the automated SSRMS Reconcile process during the QuIC+ User Group conferences held July 13 - 14, 2009. County agencies should have received the QuIC+ 7.02 patch that included a couple of minor fixes as well as several enhancements to the SSRMS Reconcile feature in QuIC+. Since this process is new for everyone, here are a few reminders:

- Ø When creating the new SSRMS Reconcile record in QuIC+ for the Apr - Jun time period use Year 2009, Quarter Second.
- Ø The Jan - Mar 4281 data should be entered into QuIC+ using the 2009/2nd quarter time frame.
- Ø The 4281 data for the Apr - Jun quarter that was due on July 15, 2009 should be entered into QuIC+ by creating a new record using 2009/3rd quarter.
- Ø Please refer to the new SSRMS QuIC+ directions contained in the E-Letter, MLS 7.02 Release sent by Maximus on August 7, 2009.

RMS and Days of Operation

BCFTA will create "holidays" for county agencies scheduled to be closed on specific days (ex. closed Fridays for economic reasons). County agencies will not receive RMS observation forms for dates and times associated with those days.

Notification of changes to an agency's days of operation warranting a change in the days and dates reflected on RMS observation forms received should be e-mailed to: BCFTA-RMS-NONQUIC_UPLOADS@jfs.ohio.gov.

Food Assistance Stimulus

County agencies electing to use their Food Assistance Stimulus (FAS) allocation to help cover ceiling excess on their IM allocation for SFY09 must e-mail the request (including amount) to their ODJFS Fiscal Supervisor by close of business **August 14, 2009.**

BCFTA will complete the necessary coding adjustments to apply the FAS allocation accordingly. Therefore, if a county agency has completed a Post Allocated Adjustment, they must **remove the**
