Topic: **Child Care Stimulus**

Child Care Stimulus funding was issued for SFY 2010 (effective July 1, 2009) as a statewide pass-thru allocation. Therefore, county specific allocations were not issued for Child Care Stimulus and county agencies were not provided associated receipt or expenditure coding (project and account).

Consequently, in an effort to ensure that Child Care Stimulus funding was exhausted prior to utilizing Child Care Services funding, **BCFTA coded the amounts requested through the weekly draw process for Child Care Services grants to Child Care Stimulus.** Child Care Stimulus funds issued were included in the weekly draw payment county agencies received. The Child Care Stimulus funds issued are reflected on your weekly voucher activity reports and over/under reports.

All of the Child Care Stimulus funds allocated have been issued to the counties.

A post allocated adjustment must be made in QuIC+ to move allowable Child Care expenditures to Child Care Stimulus to accurately reflect Child Care Stimulus expenditures in your local system and for reporting purposes. The stimulus grant reference used to complete the post allocated adjustment is currently available in QuIC+ and is identified below:
