Topic: **QulC+ Release Version 8.0 – Allowable Post-Allocated Adjustments**

---

QulC+ version 8.0 will be released on June 22. One of the primary elements of the new release affects ability of local agencies to complete post allocated adjustments. QulC+ version 8.0 will only permit allowable post allocated adjustments to be completed within the system. Any unallowable post allocated adjustments are invalid and cannot be completed in QulC+.

In the past, BCFTA has identified the post allocated adjustments local agencies are allowed to complete via communication and individual and group training sessions. Post allocated adjustments can be used to move allowable expenditures from one grant to another for linked grants. Attached is an illustration of the allowable post allocated adjustments local agencies can complete.
