Title XX TANF Transfer APS (RMS Program Code and Activity code combination 800- 875)

Effective with the Oct - Dec reporting period RMS Expenditures associated with RMS program code 800 and activity code 875 are mapped to Title XX TANF Transfer. These codes were mapped to Adult Protective Services (APS) through September 30, 2010.

Program Code 800 Title XX TANF (<200% FPL)

Activities for TANF recipients which strengthen family life and restore, maintain, or improve capabilities for self-support, self-care and independent living.

Activity Code 875 Title XX TANF Adult Protective Services

Services or activities designed to prevent or remedy abuse, neglect, or exploitation of adults who are unable to protect their own interests. Situations that may require protective services including injury due to maltreatment or family violence, lack of adequate food, clothing, or shelter, lack of essential medical treatment or rehabilitation services, and lack of necessary financial or other resource, etc.

To ensure that all expenditures are mapped correctly, please re-process allocations in the QuIC+ system and submit revised uploads for Oct – Dec quarter..

New Adult Protective Services Coding

Effective with the next observation period (March – May 2011) new RMS coding will be available for counties to capture costs associated with APS that are not eligible for Title XX or Title XX TANF. The new coding and definition follow:

Program Code 701 Adult Protective Services**Activity Code 701 Non Title XX Adult Protective Services**

Services or activities designed to prevent or remedy abuse, neglect, or exploitation of adults age sixty or over who are unable to protect their own interests. Includes situations that may require protective services that are not included in the county or State SS plan or otherwise not Title XX eligible.
