**Topic:** H.B. 153 Flexible Funding

Section 309.50.20 Amended Substitute House Bill No 153 of the 129<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, has given a CDJFS or PCSA the ability to transfer a portion or all of specific GRF allocations to a flexible funding pool for use by the county's Family and Children First Council (FCFC). The effected GRF allocations and Administrative code rules are:

Social Services Operating Allocation	5101:9-6-10
Child, Family, and Adult Community and Protective Services Allocation	5101:9-6-12.4
State Child Protective Allocation	5101:9-6-19

The purpose of this BCFTA update is to provide coding for county agencies that elect to transfer any portion of their allocations to the FCFC for the flexible funding pool.

#### **CDJFS to FCFC**

The CDJFS will code the amount transferred as an expenditure using the following financial codes:

##### *Social Service Operating*

**Project: 889 Account: 518001**

##### *Child, Family, and Adult Community and Protective Services Allocation*

**Project: 890 Account: 518001**

#### **PCSA to FCFC**

The CDJFS will code the amount transferred as an expenditure using the following financial codes:

##### *State Child Protective Allocation*

**Project: 841 Account: 518001**

The Office of Families and Children has developed formal guidance for the Family and Children First Council (FCFC) flexible funding pool. The expenditure of the pooled funds shall be made in collaboration and agreement between all local public agencies transferring the funds, the other local FCFC members and the FCFC administrative agency.
