Topic: WIA Cost Pool

Effective with the beginning of the next RMS sampling period (June 1, 2012) agencies with staff that dedicate 100% of their time to WIA programs will be in a separate cost pool.

An OAC rule packet containing proposed revisions to applicable rules has been sent for clearance (clearance #7207.) Please reference those rules for information and guidelines. If your county has staff that work only on WIA programs, please send an e-mail to the CFIS HELPDESK no later than the close of business on Monday, April 30. Please include information regarding the WIA Cost Pool RMS Coordinator, backup RMS Coordinator, and supervisors. Remember to include the name, Novell ID, and e-mail address for coordinators and supervisors.

The BCFTA RMS Administrator will establish the WIA Cost Pool for those counties in the Web RMS system and will notify you when it is available for you to enter your roster information.
