The name and definition for RMS activity code 116 has been edited to exclude the words ‘Case Management’.

This update is a name change for clarification only and does not affect what activities are allowable for eligibility determination for Ohio Works First (OWF).

The name and definition now read as follows:

Name: TANF OWF-Eligibility Determination

Definition: Includes non-PRC activities related to general administration and coordination of TANF OWF, including eligibility screening interviews; intake; review of household reports; eligibility review; benefit changes; appeal hearings; recordkeeping changes to file; overpayment preparation; IEVS activity; contract creation and administration; preparation of program plans, budgets and schedules; monitoring of programs and projects; fraud and abuse units; procurement activities; public relations; services related to accounting, litigation, audits, management of property, payroll and personnel; management information systems not related to the tracking and monitoring of TANF requirements; and preparing reports and other documents.
