

# ERROR MESSAGES ENCOUNTER DATA DRUG

The following error messages will cause a **tape reject**:

1.

SUBMITTER ID IS NOT NUMERIC

- The three digit submitter id, part of the processor control number, assigned to each submitter is not numeric.

2. ERROR ON PMF READ TO GET SUBMITTER ADDRESS FOR SUBMITTER/PROVIDER '###'

- The three digit submitter id, part of the processor control number, could not be converted to a valid seven digit provider number and the program was unable to obtain a valid address from the provider master file.

3. E 11 CLAIMS READ '#####' DOES NOT MATCH BATCH CONTROL '#####' - TAPE REJECTED

- Double check to see if the batch control record is correct. If it is then the tape is bad.

4. E 12 ALL RECORDS IN ERROR - TAPE REJECTED

The following error messages will cause a **record reject**:

1. E 01 HMO COUNTY PROVIDER NUMBER IS NOT NUMERIC

- The seven digit provider number assigned to each HMO by ODHS is not numeric.

2. E 02 RECIPIENT ID IS NOT NUMERIC

- The twelve digit recipient number assigned to each recipient by ODHS is not numeric.

3. E 04 FILL DATE IS NOT NUMERIC

- The date a prescription was filled is not numeric,

4. E 05 DRUG QUANTITY IS NOT NUMERIC

- The quantity must be numeric with known imbedded decimal points.

5. E 06 DRUG CODE NOT ON NDC FILE
  - The drug code could not be found on the NDC (blue book) file.
  
6. E 07 DRUG CODE IS NOT NUMERIC
  
7. E 08 HMO COUNTY PROVIDER NUMBER NOT ON FILE
  - The seven digit provider number assigned to each HMO by ODHS is not on the provider master.
  
8. E 09 RECIPIENT NUMBER NOT ON FILE
  - The twelve digit recipient number assigned to each recipient by ODHS is not on the recipient master.
  
9. E 10 UNIQUE CLAIM NUMBER IS MISSING
  - The fifteen digit unique claim number assigned by HMO and placed in the last name field is missing.
  
10. E 13 UNABLE TO CONVERT FILL DATE
  - The date a prescription was filled could not be converted to the MMIS date.
