

Transitions MRDD Waiver

The Transitions MRDD Waiver benefit package includes of nursing services, personal care assistance services and/or skilled therapy services, and waiver-specific services such as home modifications, home-delivered meals, adult day health care, respite care, supplemental transportation, adaptive/assistive devices, and emergency response systems.

It is designed to meet the needs of consumers eligible for institutional Medicaid who have been assessed to require an ICFMR/DD (intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded/developmentally disabled) level of care.

This waiver is not open to new enrollees. This means you cannot apply for enrollment directly onto the Transitions MRDD waiver. You must first be on the Ohio Home Care Waiver and be “transitioned” to the Transitions MRDD waiver because your condition has changed and you now meet the ICF/MR level of care.

Who administers the Transitions MRDD Waiver program?

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services administers this waiver program. It contracts with a case management agency, CareStar, to provide case management services.
