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Proposed OGT Options

- Proposed options could become available to students Jan. 1, 2016
 - This only applies to students required to pass the OGT
 - (Students entering high school before July 1, 2014)
- OGT **may not** be used as part of the **new** graduation requirements
 - (Students entering high school on or after July 1, 2014)

Emphasis is placed on the words "may not" and the word "new")

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2016-17 Budget Bill (HB 64) stipulates that

Students entering high school before July 1, 2014 and who are required to pass the Ohio Graduation Tests (OGTs) may now:

1. Use old graduation requirements (OGT)
2. New: Use new graduation requirements

3. New: Use new testing options to fulfill old graduation requirements

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Big Picture

The ELA, math, science, and social studies tests will be delivered using:

- one test vendor,
- one test delivery system,
- one test administration system, and
- one testing window.

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Testing Update

- Shorter
- Districts may choose delivery method
- Districts will choose dates from the testing window
