"Program" represents identified WIA funding streams for programs serving adults and youth.

"State /Local Indicators of Performance" represents a total of nine (9) performance measures, called Common Measures, for PY 2009: They consist of six (6) Adult measures (for both Adult and Dislocated Workers: Entered Employment, Employment Retention, Average Earnings) and three (3) Youth and lifelong Learning measures (Placement in Employment or Education, Attainment of a Degree or Certificate, Literacy and Numeracy Gains).

"State Negotiated Performance Level" represents Ohio's expected level of performance which is negotiated with the Department of Labor for the required "State/Local Indicators of Performance."

"80% of Negotiated Level" represents Ohio's minimum level of performance, which must be attained in order to avoid potential federal sanctions, and is equal to "State Negotiated Performance Level" X .80.
