

# MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JANUARY 2003

## OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of January 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 87,275; recipients totaled 197,502 and money payments totaled \$26,100,967. The percent change from December 2002 to January 2003 was -0.1% for assistance groups; -0.2% for recipients, and -1.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,112 assistance groups; 180,357 recipients, and \$24,475,480 in money payments issued for January 2003. The percent change from December 2002 to January 2003 was -0.3% for assistance groups; -0.6% for recipients, and -1.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,163; recipients 17,145, and money payments were \$1,625,487. The percent change from December 2002 to January 2003 was 4.5% for assistance groups; 3.7% for recipients and 1.4% for money payments.

## FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,428 children received \$12,572,951 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of January 2003. Included in this total were 6,774 foster care children who received \$5,982,943 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,127 or 12.8% were in foster family homes who received \$1,344,532 and 3,647 or 14.9% children in child care institutions who received \$4,638,411 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,654 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,590,008 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$514.69.

## DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of January 2003, there were 15,699 assistance groups; 16,114 recipients, and \$2,010,561 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$124.77. Total DA expenditures for medical services for January 2003 were \$8,345,772. Of this total, \$5,781,144 or 69.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$2,066,151 or 24.8% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 20,570 recipients for an average expenditure of \$ 405.73 per recipient.


## FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during January 2003 decreased to 841,323 by 1,055 or - 0.1% from 842,378 persons reported in December 2002. Households decreased by 362 or -0.1% over December 2002 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during January 2003 decreased by \$1,272,223 or -1.8% from \$72,028,907 reported in December 2002 to \$70,756,684 reported in January 2003. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$1.41 or -1.6% from those issued in December 2002. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$85.51 in December 2002 to \$84.10 in January 2003.



During the Last 25 Months




# Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




# DA Cash Assistance Groups




# Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
