MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR FEBRUARY 2006

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of February 2006, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 81,601; recipients totaled 176,565 and money payments totaled \$27,201,969. The percent change from January 2006 to February 2006 was -1.7% for assistance groups; -2.4% for recipients, and 1.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 77,547 assistance groups; 160,208 recipients, and \$25,376,164 in money payments issued for February 2006. The percent change from January 2006 to February 2006 was -1.7% for assistance groups; -2.5% for recipients, and 1.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,054; recipients, 16,357 and money payments were \$1,825,805. The percent change from January 2006 to February 2006 was -1.9% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients and 3.7% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 27,024 children received \$14,006,590 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of February 2006. Included in this total were 6,577 foster care children who received \$6,144,134 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,940 or 10.9% were in foster family homes who received \$1,254,701 and 3,637 or 13.5% children in child care institutions who received \$4,889,434 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 20,447 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,862,456 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$518.30.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of February 2006, there were 12,089 assistance groups; 12,165 recipients, and \$1,734,556 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$142.59. Total DA expenditures for medical services for February 2006 were \$3,129,225. Of this total, \$2,156,836 or 68.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$ 753,406 or 24.1% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 6,821 recipients for an average expenditure of \$458.76 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during February 2006 decreased to 1,040,537 by 10,991 or -1.0% from 1,051,528 persons reported in January 2006. Households decreased by 5,130 or -1.1% over January 2006 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during February 2006 decreased by \$672,050 or -0.7% from \$103,129,520 reported in January 2006 to \$102,457,470 reported in February 2006. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.39 or 0.4% from those issued in January 2006. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$ 98.08 in January 2006 to \$98.47 in February 2006.

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

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




