## MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR MARCH 2006

### OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of March 2006, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 83,264; recipients totaled 180,744 and money payments totaled \$26,782,238. The percent change from February 2006 to March 2006 was 2.0% for assistance groups; 2.4% for recipients, and -1.5% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 79,005 assistance groups; 163,689 recipients, and \$24,981,565 in money payments issued for March 2006. The percent change from February 2006 to March 2006 was 1.9% for assistance groups; 2.2% for recipients, and -1.6% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,259; recipients, 17,055 and money payments were \$1,800,673. The percent change from February 2006 to March 2006 was 5.1% for assistance groups; 4.3% for recipients and -1.4% for money payments.

### FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 27,204 children received \$14,381,303 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of March 2006. Included in this total were 6,700 foster care children who received \$6,462,696 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,834 or 10.4% were in foster family homes who received \$1,377,714 and 3,866 or 14.2% children in child care institutions who received \$5,084,982 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 20,504 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,918,607 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$528.65.

### DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of March 2006, there were 12,463 assistance groups; 12,555 recipients, and \$1,761,824 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$140.33 Total DA expenditures for medical services for March 2006 were \$ 3,771,681. Of this total, \$2,577,965 or 68.4% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$ 862,309 or 22.9% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 6,754 recipients for an average expenditure of \$558.44 per recipient.





# No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




# No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




# DA Cash Assistance Groups




