

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR APRIL 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of April 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,973; recipients totaled 195,740 and money payments totaled \$26,162,193. The percent change from March 2003 to April 2003 was 0.8% for assistance groups; 0.7% for recipients, and 0.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,728 assistance groups; 178,408 recipients, and \$24,523,197 in money payments issued for April 2003. The percent change from March 2003 to April 2003 was 0.8% for assistance groups; 0.6% for recipients, and 0.9% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,245; recipients 17,332, and money payments were \$1,638,996. The percent change from March 2003 to April 2003 was 1.1% for assistance groups; 0.9% for recipients and 0.2% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 25,432 children received \$14,225,007 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of April 2003. Included in this total were 7,528 foster care children who received \$7,574,202 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,301 or 13.0% were in foster family homes who received \$1,427,141 and 4,227 or 16.6% children in child care institutions who received \$6,147,061 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,904 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,650,805 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$559.33.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of April 2003, there were 16,537 assistance groups; 16,970 recipients, and \$2,027,682 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$119.49. Total DA expenditures for medical services for April 2003 were \$9,883,662. Of this total, \$6,514,612 or 65.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$2,751,380 or 27.8% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 22,616 recipients for an average expenditure of \$437.02 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2003 decreased to 853,470 by 6,284 or -0.7% from 859,754 persons reported in March 2003. Households decreased by 8,033 or -0.5% over March 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2003 decreased by \$ 1,602,761 or -2.2% from \$74,487,017 reported in March 2003 to \$72,884,256 reported in March 2003. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$ 1.24 or -1.4% from those issued in March 2003. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$86.64 in March 2003 to \$85.40 in April 2003.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
