MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR MAY 2006

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of May 2006, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 81,827; recipients totaled 176,854 and money payments totaled \$26,757,585. The percent change from April 2006 to May 2006 was 2.2% for assistance groups; 2.5% for recipients, and 1.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 77,805 assistance groups; 160,685 recipients, and \$25,034,827 in money payments issued for May 2006. The percent change from April 2006 to May 2006 was 2.2% for assistance groups; 2.6% for recipients, and 1.2% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,022; recipients, 16,169 and money payments were \$1,722,758. The percent change from April 2006 to May 2006 was 1.5% for assistance groups; 2.0% for recipients and -0.8% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 27,254 children received \$13,784,900 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of May 2006. Included in this total were 6,672 foster care children who received \$5,859,856 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,794 or 10.3% were in foster family homes who received \$1,218,132 and 3,878 or 14.2% children in child care institutions who received \$4,641,724 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 20,582 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,925,044 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$505.79.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of May 2006, there were 13,219 assistance groups; 13,319 recipients, and \$1,986,853 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$149.17. Total DA expenditures for medical services for May 2006 were \$3,185,546. Of this total, \$2,232,150 or 70.1% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$736,019 or 23.1% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 5,946 recipients for an average expenditure of \$535.75 per recipient.





No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




