MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JUNE 2006

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of June 2006, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 83,126; recipients totaled 179,647 and money payments totaled \$24,981,481. The percent change from May 2006 to June 2006 was 1.6% for assistance groups; 1.6% for recipients, and -6.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 79,157 assistance groups; 163,683 recipients, and \$23,449,018 in money payments issued for June 2006. The percent change from May 2006 to June 2006 was 1.7% for assistance groups; 1.9% for recipients, and -6.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,969; recipients, 15,964 and money payments were \$1,532,463. The percent change from May 2006 to June 2006 was -1.3% for assistance groups; -1.3% for recipients and -11.0% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 27,007 children received \$14,506,729 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of June 2006. Included in this total were 6,415 foster care children who received \$6,570,956 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,745 or 10.2% were in foster family homes who received \$1,272,086 and 3,670 or 13.6% children in child care institutions who received \$5,298,869 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 20,592 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,935,773 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$537.15.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of June 2006, there were 13,947 assistance groups; 14,049 recipients, and \$1,941,545 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$138.20. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2006 were \$2,959,897. Of this total, \$2,142,243 or 72.4% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$615,506 or 20.8% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 5,633 recipients for an average expenditure of \$525.46 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2006 increased to 1,073,268 by 4,226 or 0.4% from 1,069,042 persons reported in May 2006. Households increased by 2,153 or 0.4% over May 2006 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2006 increased by \$59,643 or 0.1% from \$106,934,328 reported in May 2006 to \$106,993,971 reported in June 2006. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.34 or -0.3% from those issued in May 2006. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$100.03 in May 2006 to \$99.69 in June 2006.

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

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




