MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JUNE 2007

OHIO WORKS FIRST (OWF)

For the month of June 2007, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 76,158; recipients totaled 160,841 and money payments totaled \$25,149,407. The percent change from May 2007 to June 2007 was -3.5% for assistance groups; -4.1% for recipients, and 4.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 73,433 assistance groups; 149,827 recipients, and \$23,962,387 in money payments issued for June 2007. The percent change from May 2007 to June 2007 was -3.2% for assistance groups; -3.6% for recipients, and 4.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 2,725; recipients, 11,014 and money payments were \$1,187,020. The percent change from May 2007 to June 2007 was -11.0% for assistance groups; -10.2% for recipients and -1.8% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 23,939 children received \$18,639,187 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of June 2007. Included in this total were 5,326 foster care children who received \$4,509,378 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,357 or 9.8% were in foster family homes who received \$1,051,769 and 2,969 or 12.4% children in child care institutions who received \$3,457,609 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,613 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$14,129,809 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$ 778.61.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of June 2007, there were 15,064 assistance groups; 15,145 recipients, and \$2,347,409 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$155.00. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2007 were \$ 1,612,728. Of this total, \$1,238,655 or 76.8% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$289,729 or 18.0% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 3,212 recipients for an average expenditure of \$502.09 per recipient.

FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES BENEFITS (FNS)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2007 increased to 1,087,441 by 6,660 or 0.6% from 1,080,781 persons reported in May 2007. Households increased by 2,522 or 0.5% over May 2007 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2007 increased by \$ 191,441 or 0.2% from \$108,138,296 reported in May 2007 to \$108,329,737 reported in June 2007. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$.44 or -0.4% from those issued in May 2007. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$100.06 reported in May 2007 to \$ 99.62 reported in June 2007.

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

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




