

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR AUGUST 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of August 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,874; recipients totaled 193,974 and money payments totaled \$26,411,351. The percent change from July 2003 to August 2003 was 0.5% for assistance groups; 0.4% for recipients, and 2.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,071 assistance groups; 178,508 recipients, and \$24,925,334 in money payments issued for August 2003. The percent change from July 2003 to August 2003 was 0.6% for assistance groups; 0.6% for recipients, and 2.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,803; recipients 15,466, and money payments were \$1,486,018. The percent change from July 2003 to August 2003 was -1.7% for assistance groups;-2.1% for recipients and 0.3% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 26,113 children received \$14,696,807 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of August 2003. Included in this total were 7,803 foster care children who received \$7,855,364 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,294 or 12.6% were in foster family homes who received \$1,391,372 and 4,509 or 17.3% children in child care institutions who received \$6,463,993 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,310 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,841,442 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$562.82.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of August 2003, there were 13,750 assistance groups; 13,921 recipients, and \$1,666,480 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$119.71. Total DA expenditures for medical services for August 2003 were \$7,709,112. Of this total, \$5,078,023 or 65.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$2,132,984 or 27.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 21,040 recipients for an average expenditure of \$366.40 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during August 2003 increased to 884,945 by 267 or 0.0% from 884,678 persons reported in July 2003. Households increased by 244 or 0.1% over July 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during August 2003 increased by \$1,666,953 or 2.2% from \$75,612,953 reported in July 2003 to \$77,279,906 reported in August 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.86 or 2.2% from those issued in July 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$85.47 in July 2003 to \$87.33 in August 2003.

All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
