

# MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2002

## OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of November 2002, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,481; recipients totaled 195,406 and money payments totaled \$26,041,975. The percent change from October 2002 to November 2002 was 0.3% for assistance groups; 0.3% for recipients, and -1.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,780 assistance groups; 180,040 recipients, and \$24,595,097 in money payments issued for November 2002. The percent change from October 2002 to November 2002 was 0.2% for assistance groups; 0.0% for recipients, and -1.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,701; recipients 15,366, and money payments were \$1,446,878. The percent change from October 2002 to November 2002 was 3.4% for assistance groups; 3.7% for recipients and 3.9% for money payments.

## FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 23,882 children received \$11,556,365 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of November 2002. Included in this total were 6,447 foster care children who received \$5,184,036 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,274 or 13.7% were in foster family homes who received \$1,273,273 and 3,173 or 13.3% children in child care institutions who received \$3,910,763 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,435 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,372,329 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$483.89.

## DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of November 2002, there were 14,989 assistance groups; 15,366 recipients, and \$1,859,545 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$120.66. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2002 were \$6,757,393. Of this total, \$4,570,680 or 67.6% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,792,678 or 26.5% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 19,330 recipients for an average expenditure of \$349.58 per recipient.


## FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2002 increased to 804,746 by 22,397 or 2.9% from 782,349 persons reported in October 2002. Households increased by 6,507 or 1.9% over October 2002 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2002 increased by \$ 816,725 or 1.2% from \$67,169,736 reported in October 2002 to \$67,986,461 reported in November 2002. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$1.38 or -1.6% from those issued in October 2002. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$85.86 in October 2002 to \$84.48 in November 2002.



During the Last 25 Months




## Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




# DA Cash Assistance Groups




# Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
