

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR DECEMBER 2002

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of December 2002, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 87,335; recipients totaled 197,944 and money payments totaled \$26,531,751. The percent change from November 2002 to December 2002 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 1.3% for recipients, and 1.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,350 assistance groups; 181,407 recipients, and \$24,928,511 in money payments issued for December 2002. The percent change from November 2002 to December 2002 was 0.7% for assistance groups; 0.8% for recipients, and 1.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,985; recipients 16,537, and money payments were \$1,603,240. The percent change from November 2002 to December 2002 was 7.7% for assistance groups; 7.6% for recipients and 10.8% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 23,836 children received \$12,756,184 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of December 2002. Included in this total were 6,305 foster care children who received \$6,257,954 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,094 or 13.0% were in foster family homes who received \$1,302,679 and 3,211 or 13.5% children in child care institutions who received \$4,955,275 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,531 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,498,230 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$535.16.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of December 2002, there were 15,258 assistance groups; 15,672 recipients, and \$1,922,076 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$122.64. Total DA expenditures for medical services for December 2002 were \$6,927,337. Of this total, \$4,579,159 or 66.1% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,932,720 or 27.9% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 19,314 recipients for an average expenditure of \$358.67 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2002 increased to 842,378 by 37,632 or 4.7% from 804,746 persons reported in November 2002. Households increased by 15,443 or 4.3% over November 2002 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2002 increased by \$4,042,446 or 5.9% from \$67,986,461 reported in November 2002 to \$72,028,907 reported in December 2002. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.03 or 1.2% from those issued in November 2002. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$84.48 in November 2002 to \$85.51 in December 2002.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
