

# MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR DECEMBER 2003

## OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of December 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 87,976; recipients totaled 196,993 and money payments totaled \$27,027,051. The percent change from November 2003 to December 2003 was 2.3% for assistance groups; 2.8% for recipients, and 3.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,952 assistance groups; 180,532 recipients, and \$25,390,802 in money payments issued for December 2003. The percent change from November 2003 to December 2003 was 2.0% for assistance groups; 2.3% for recipients, and 3.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,024; recipients, 16,461, and money payments were \$1,636,249. The percent change from November 2003 to December 2003 was 8.1% for assistance groups; 8.3% for recipients and 12.3% for money payments.

## FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 25,871 children received \$13,824,267 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of December 2003. Included in this total were 7,104 foster care children who received \$6,706,422 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,909 or 11.2% were in foster family homes who received \$1,244,618 and 4,195 or 16.3% children in child care institutions who received \$5,461,804 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,767 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,117,844 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$534.35.

## DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of December 2003, there were 12,898 assistance groups; 13,025 recipients, and \$1,640,295 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$125.93. Total DA expenditures for medical services for December 2003 were \$7,533,710. Of this total, \$5,223,459 or 69.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,859,607 or 24.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 16,669 recipients for an average expenditure of \$451.96 per recipient.

## FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2003 increased to 935,770 by 33,780 or 3.7% from 901,990 persons reported in November 2003. Households increased by 14,796 or 3.7% over November 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2003 increased by \$4,291,492 or 5.4% from \$79,289,677 reported in November 2003 to \$83,581,169 reported in December 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.41 or 1.6% from those issued in November 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$87.91 in November 2003 to \$89.32 in December 2003.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



During the Last 25 Months




## Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




# DA Cash Assistance Groups




# Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
