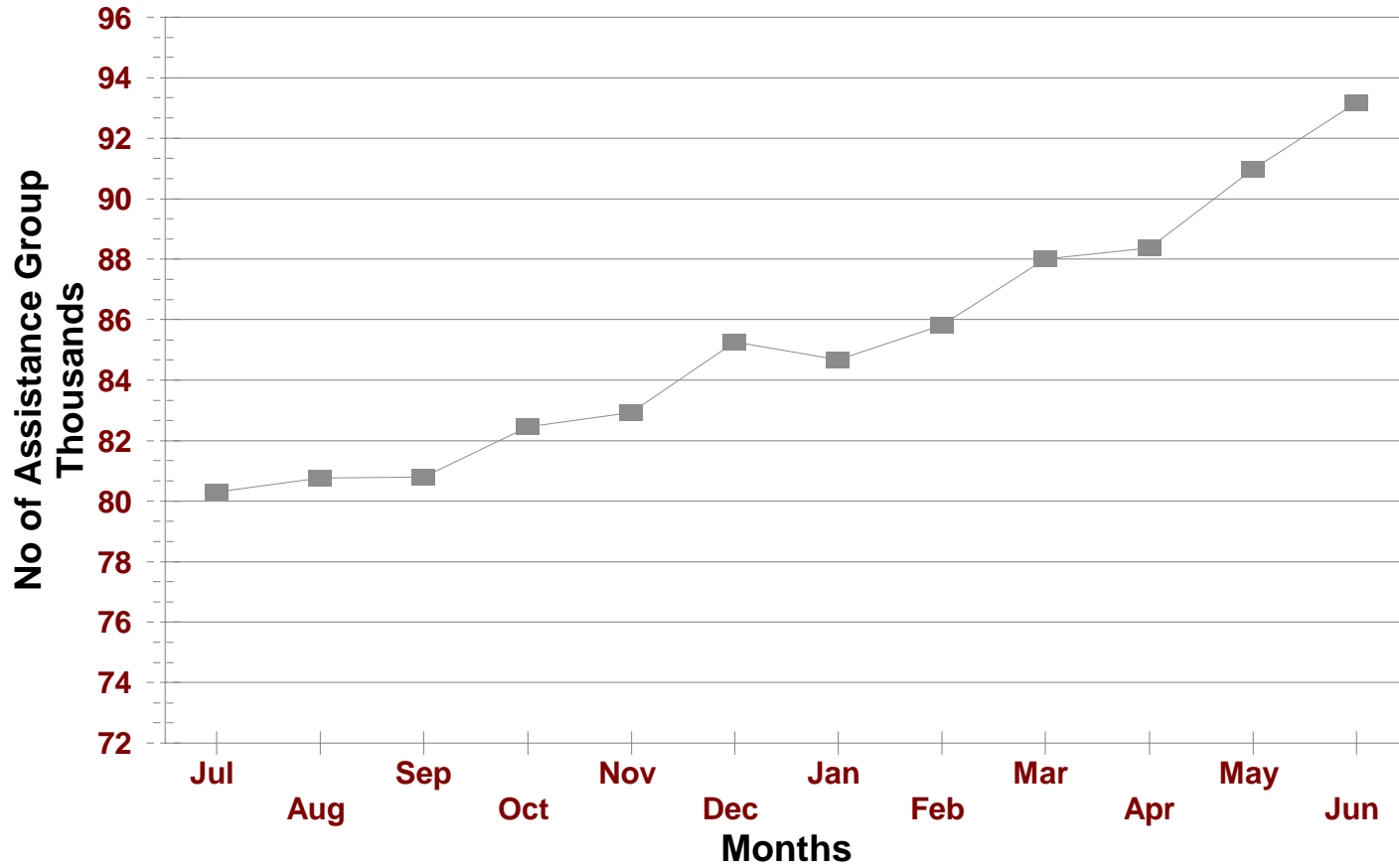

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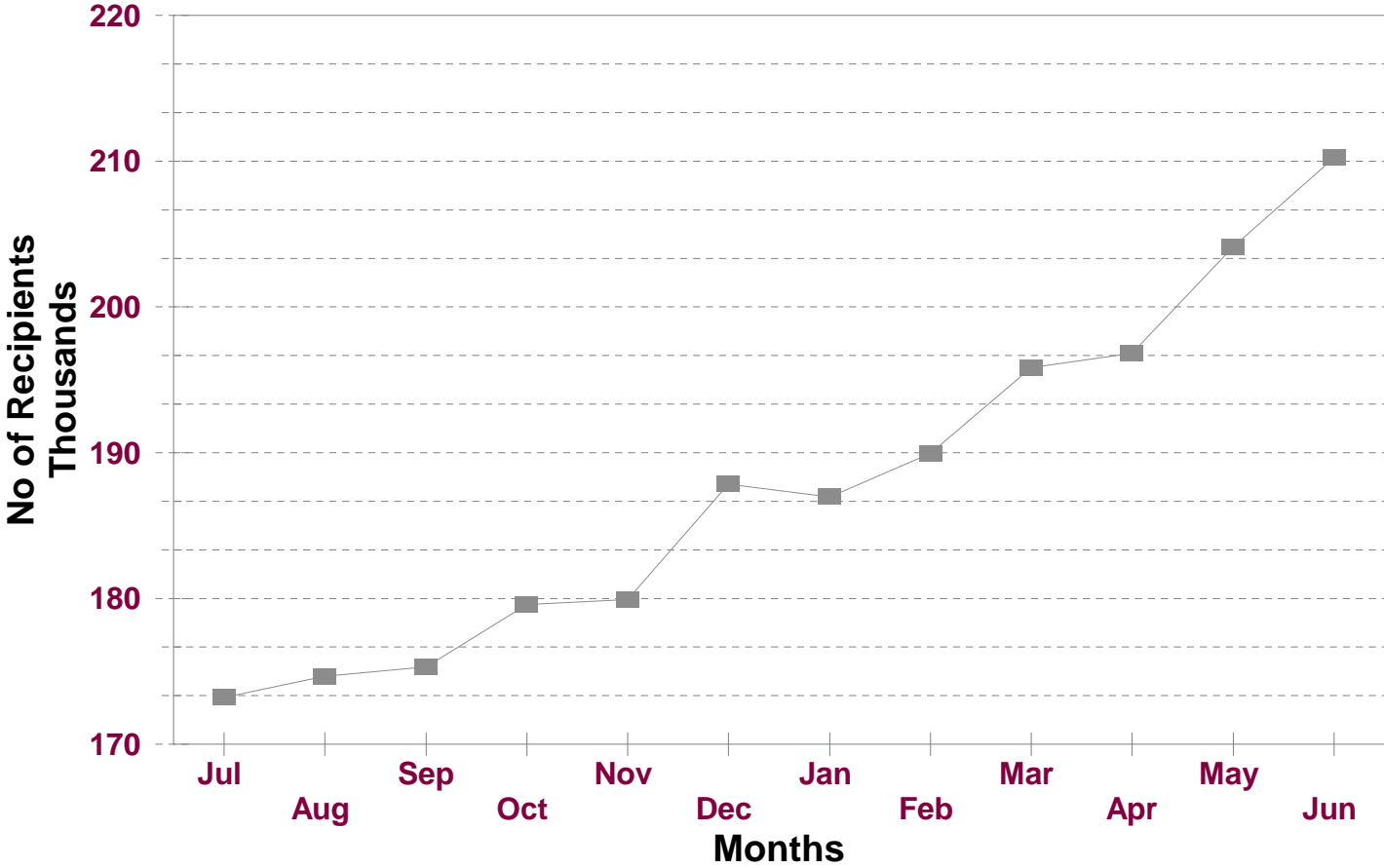

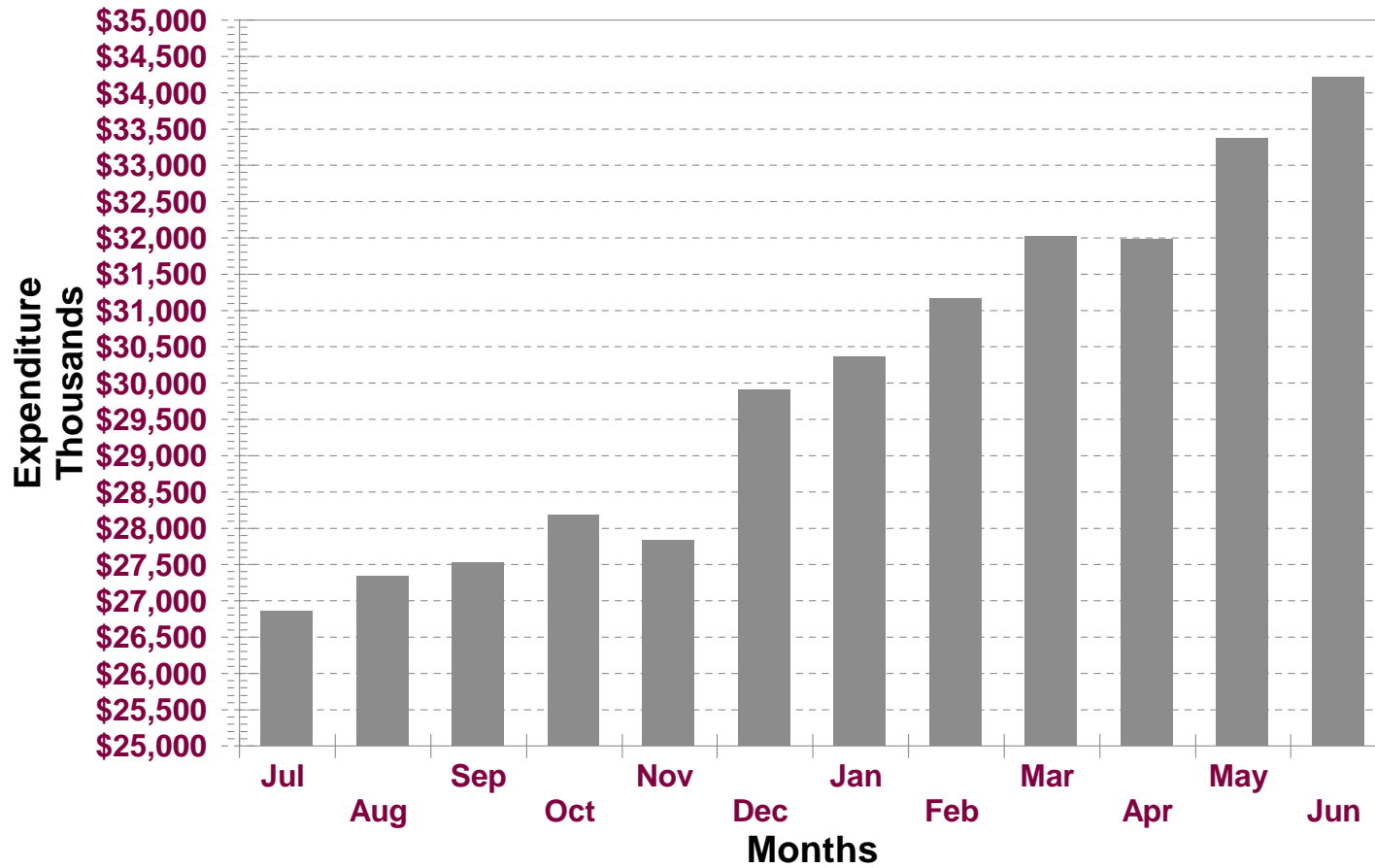
No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During State Fiscal Year 2009

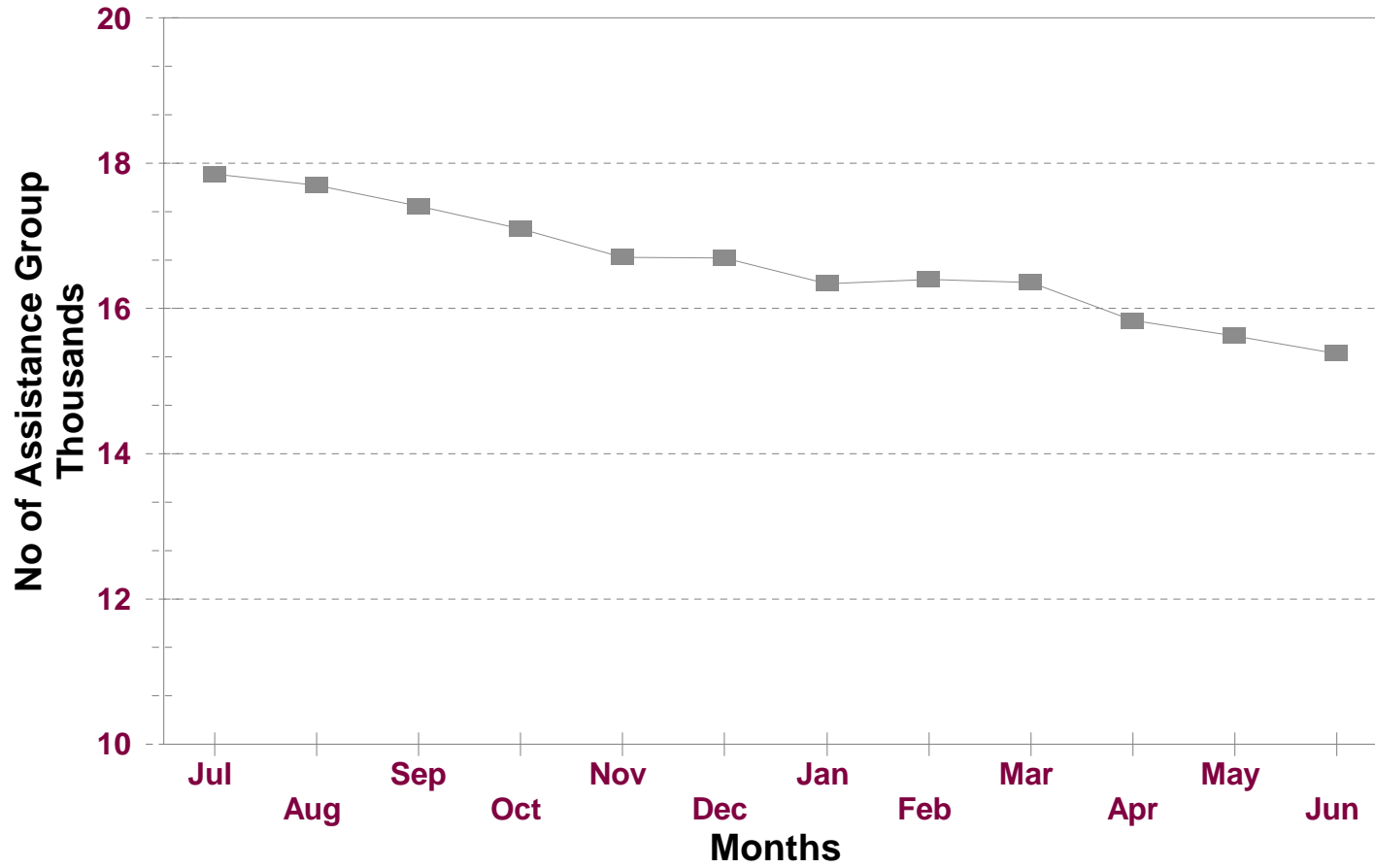

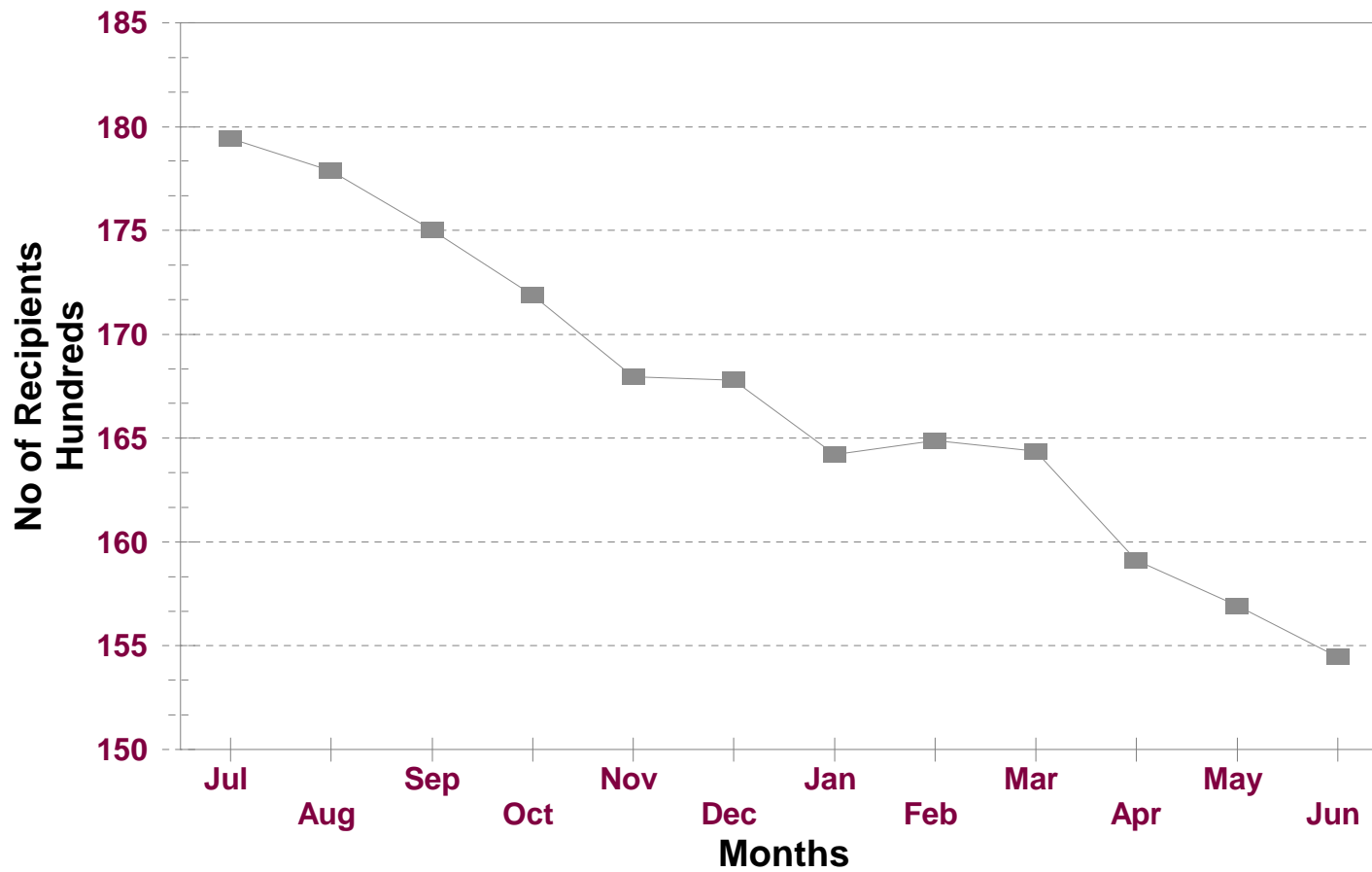

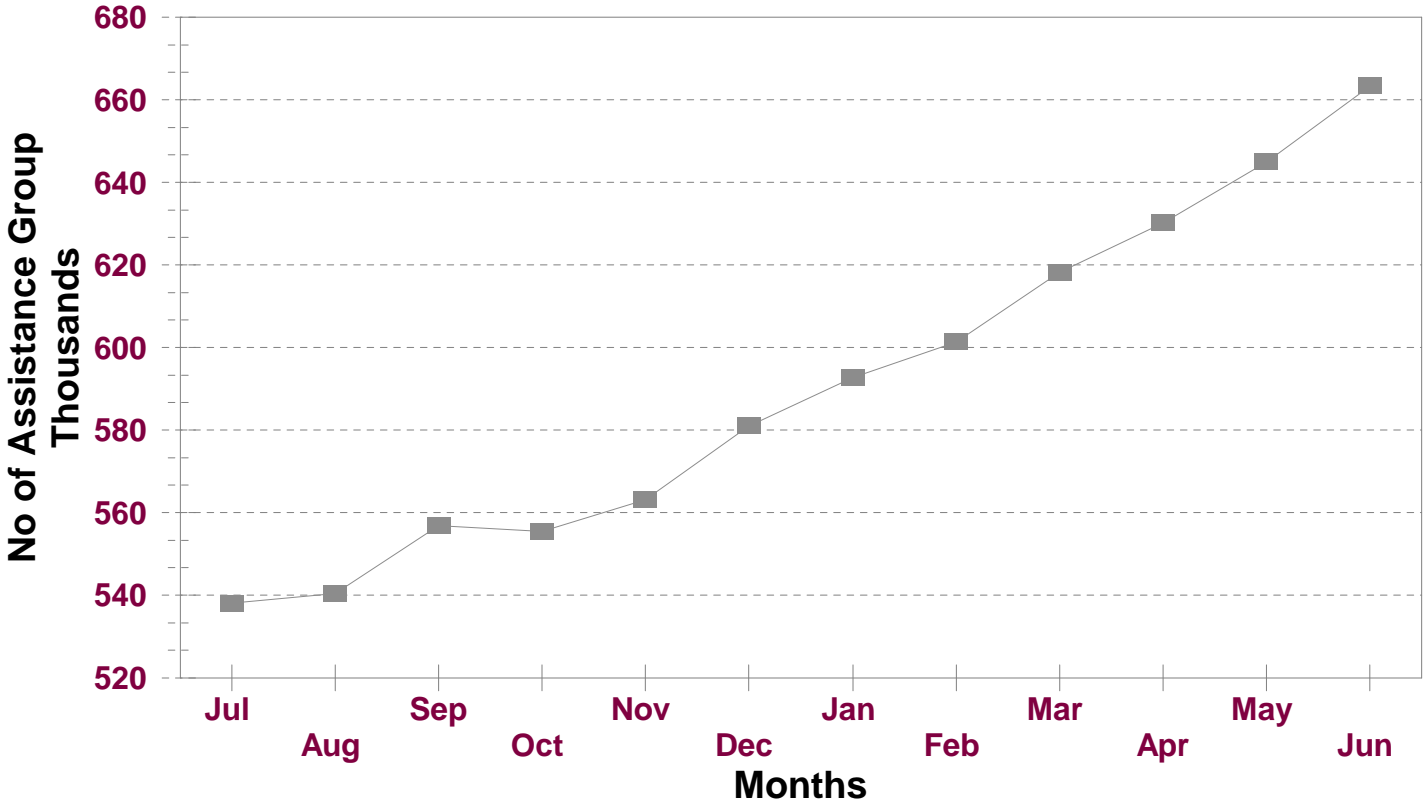

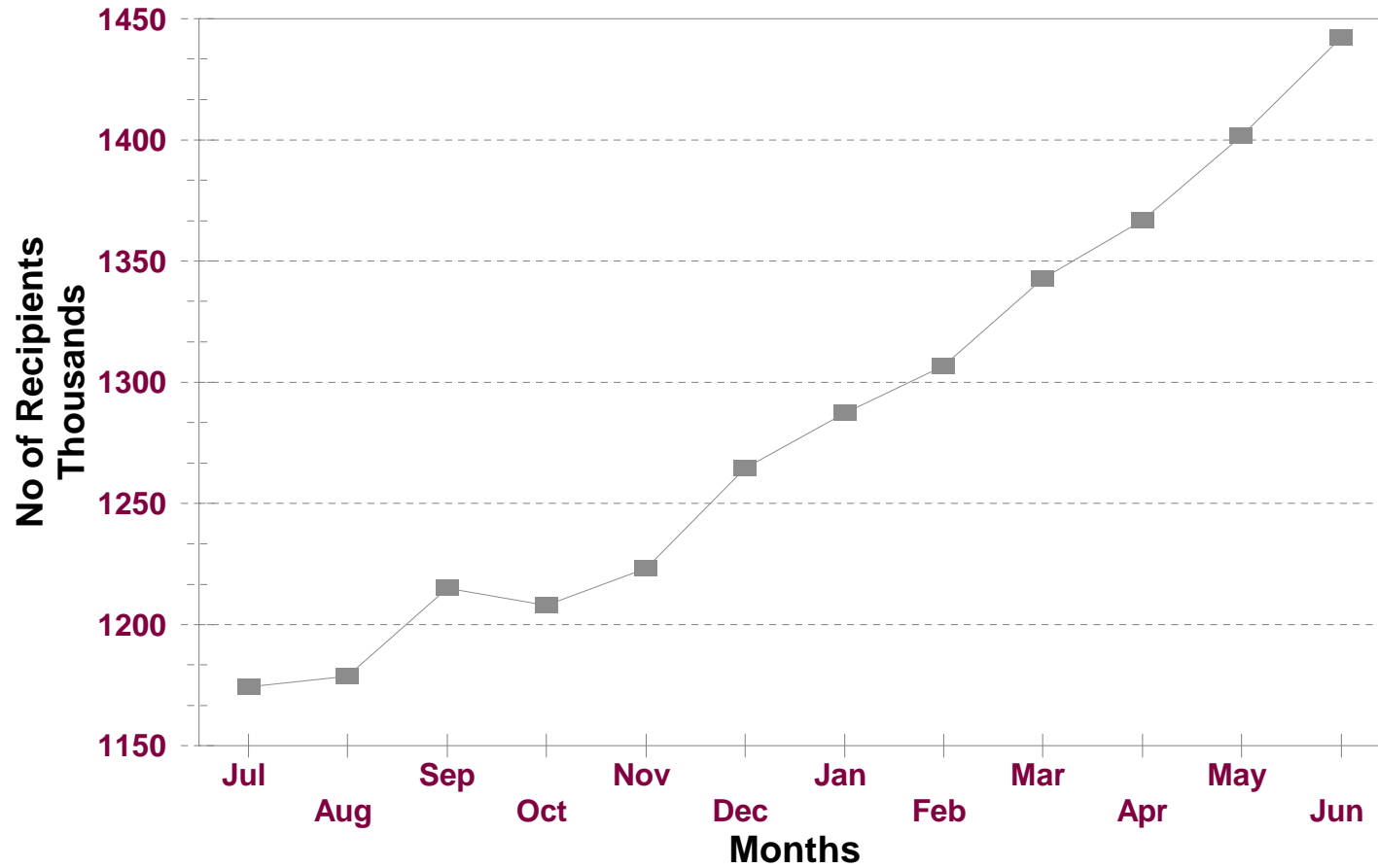
