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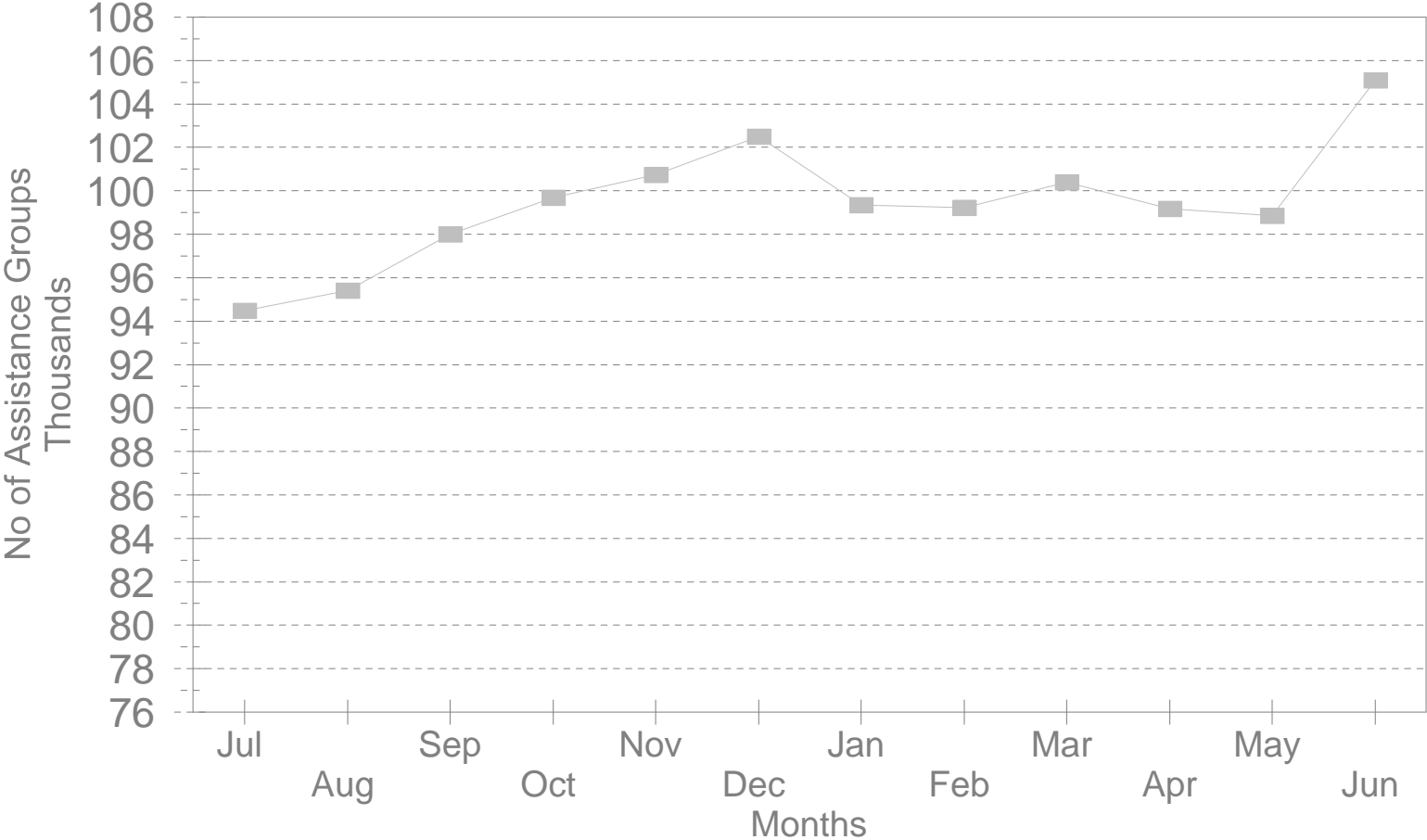

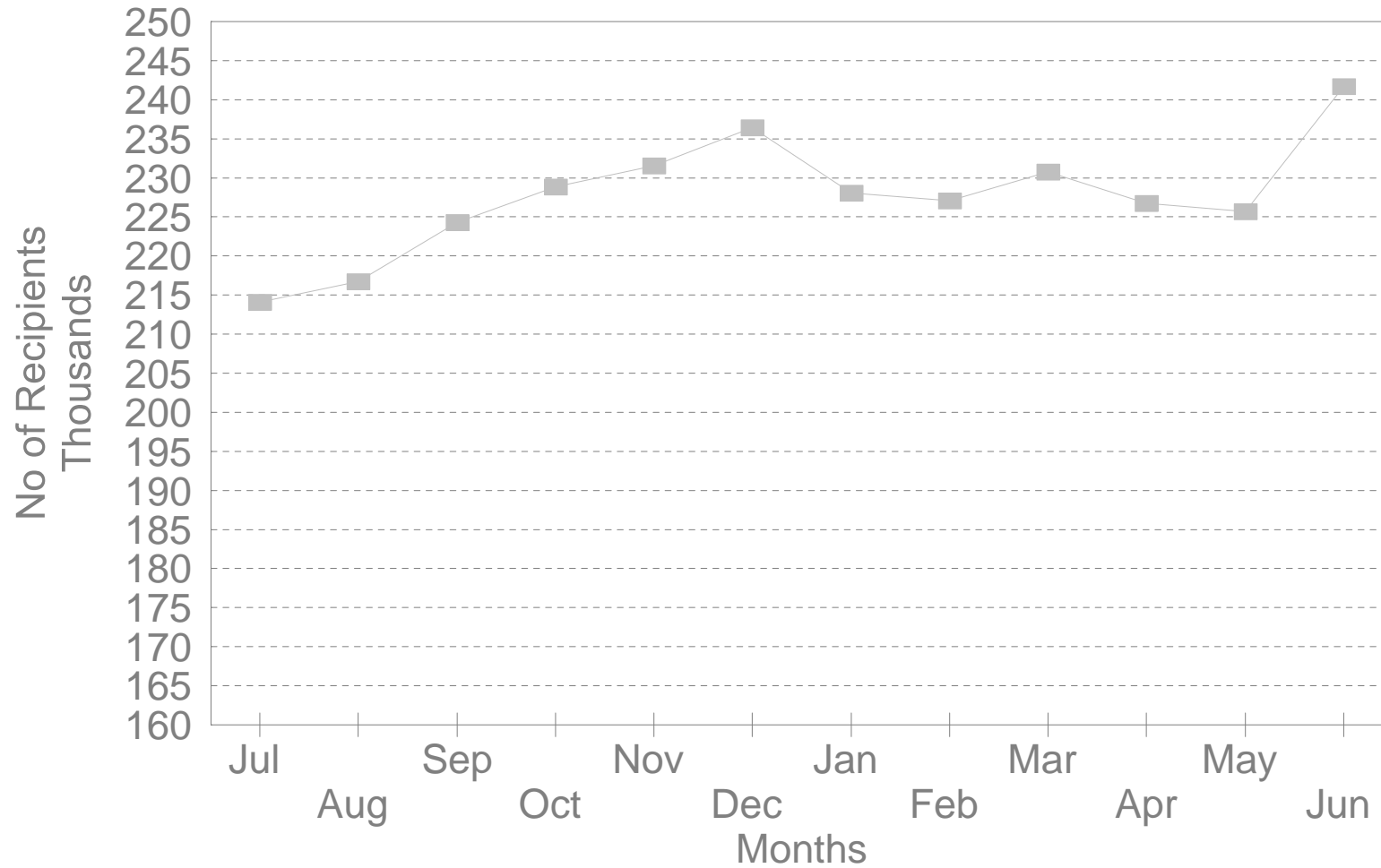

For State Fiscal Year 2010

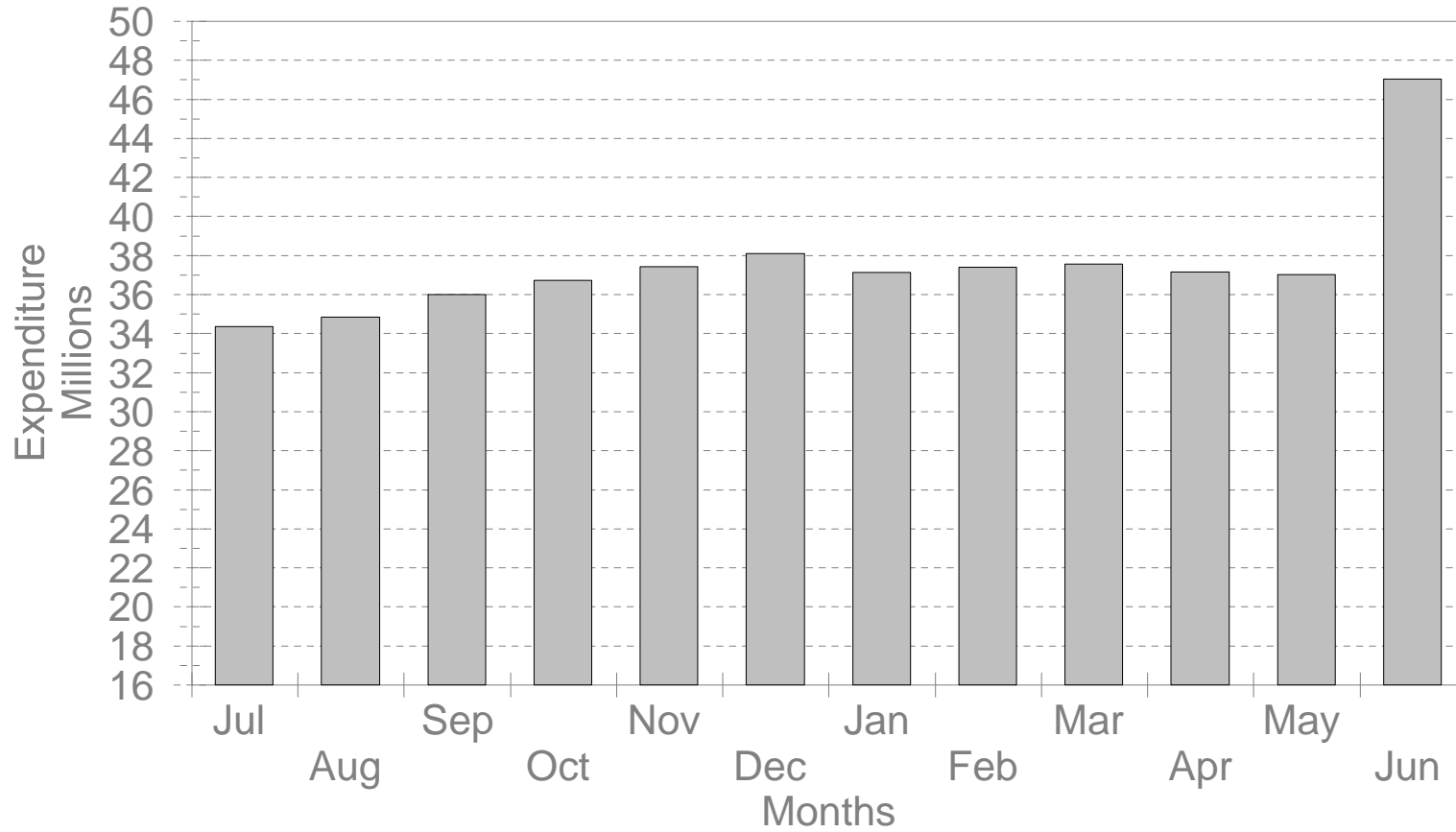


No of OWF Combined Recipients For State Fiscal Year 2010

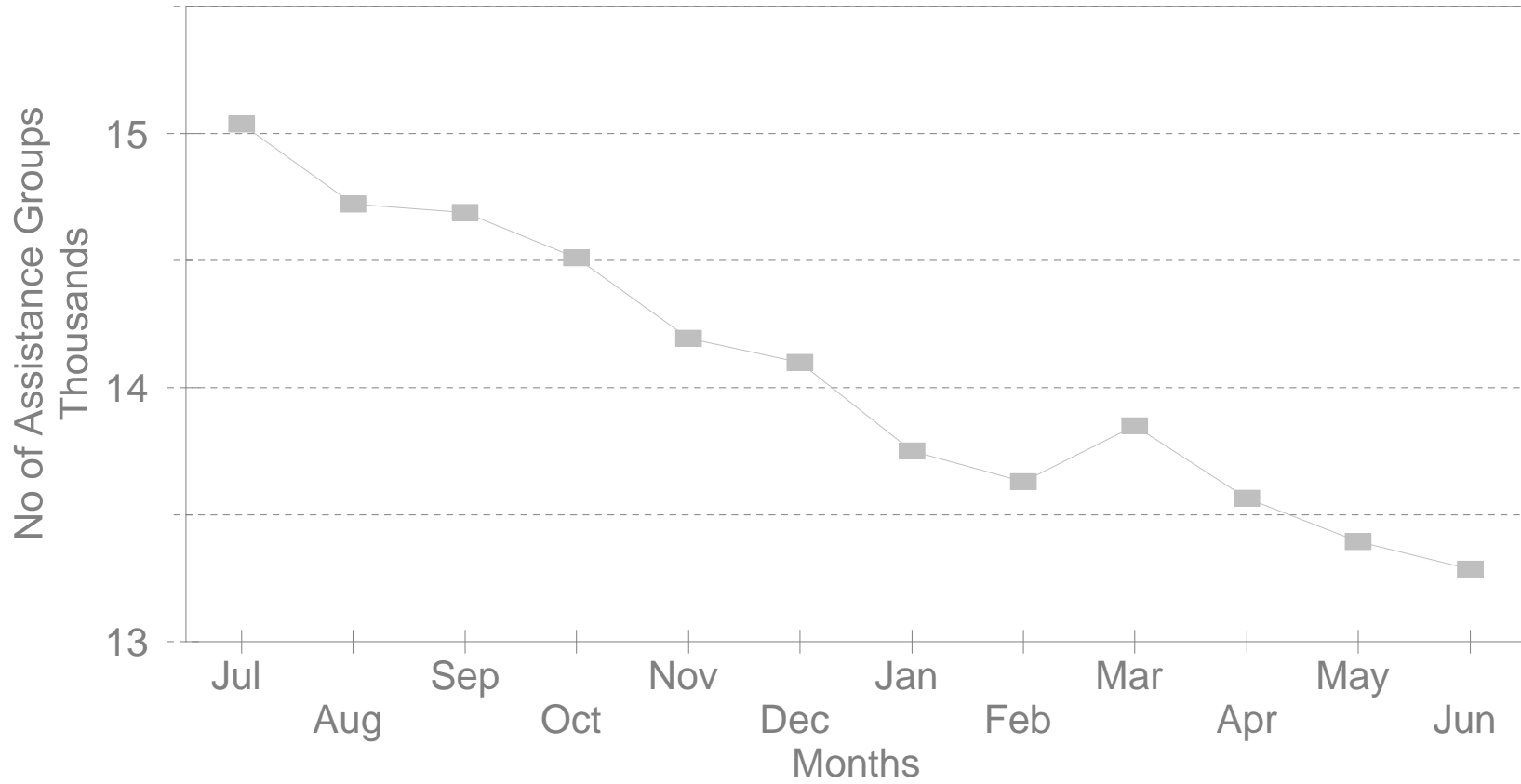

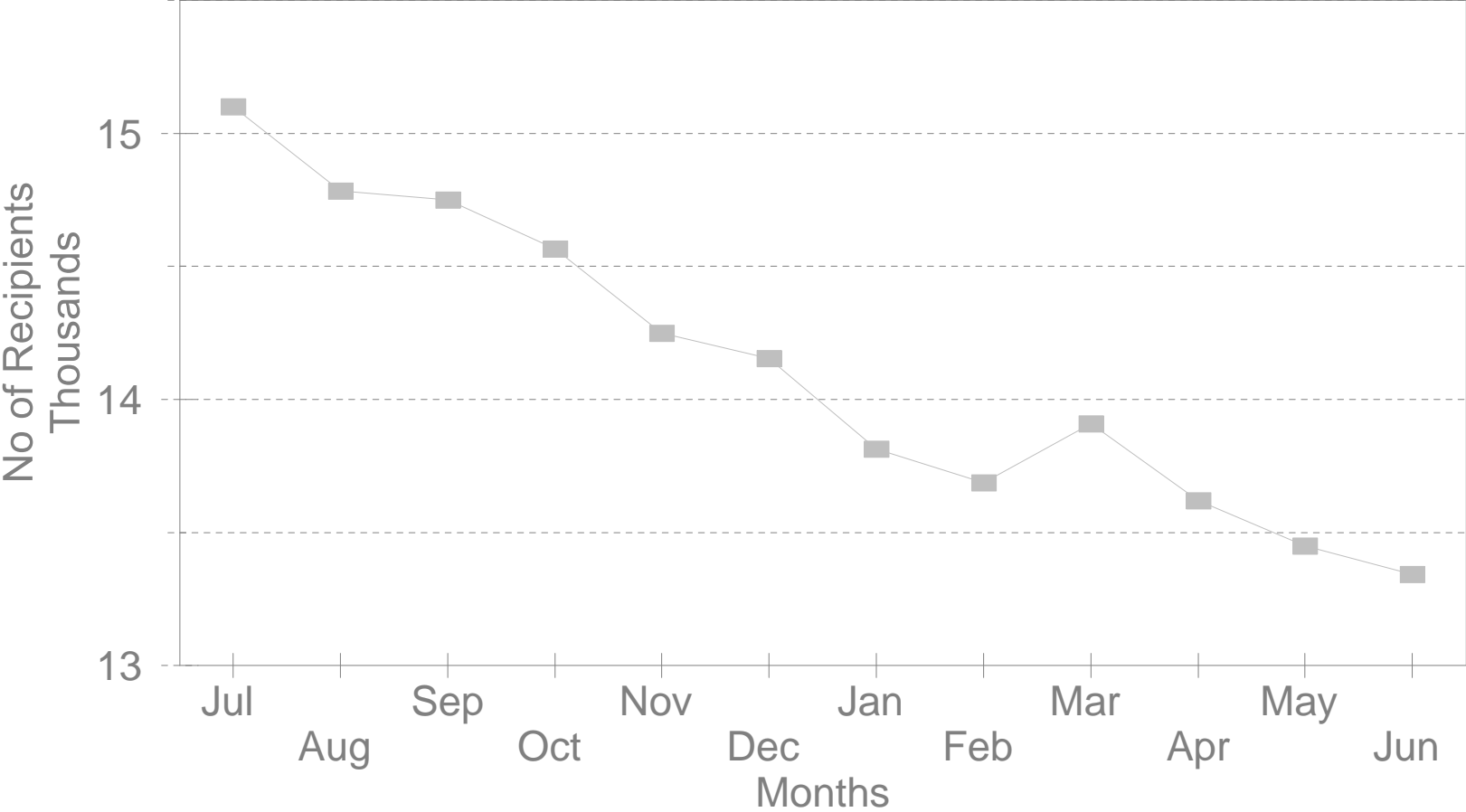

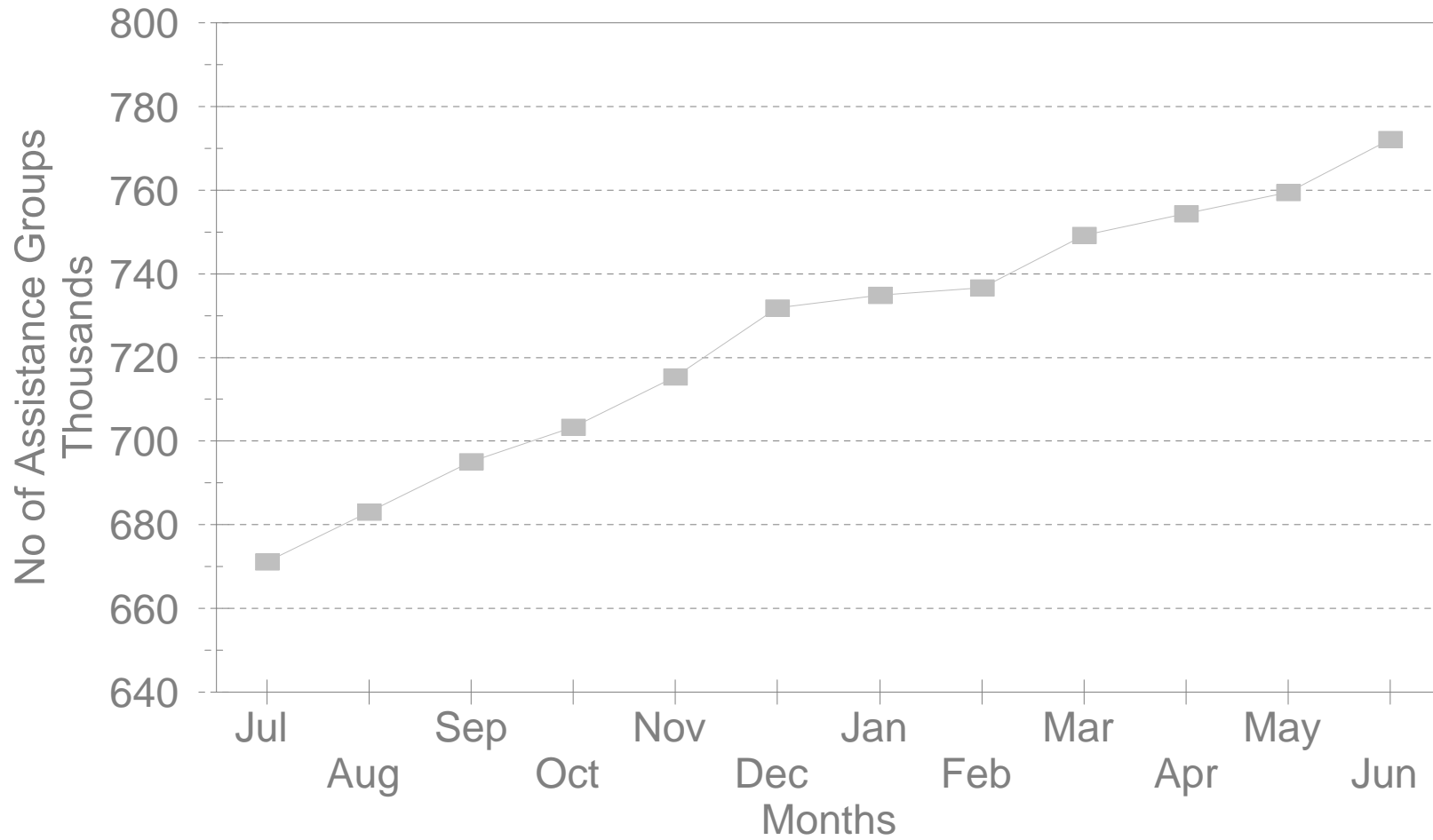

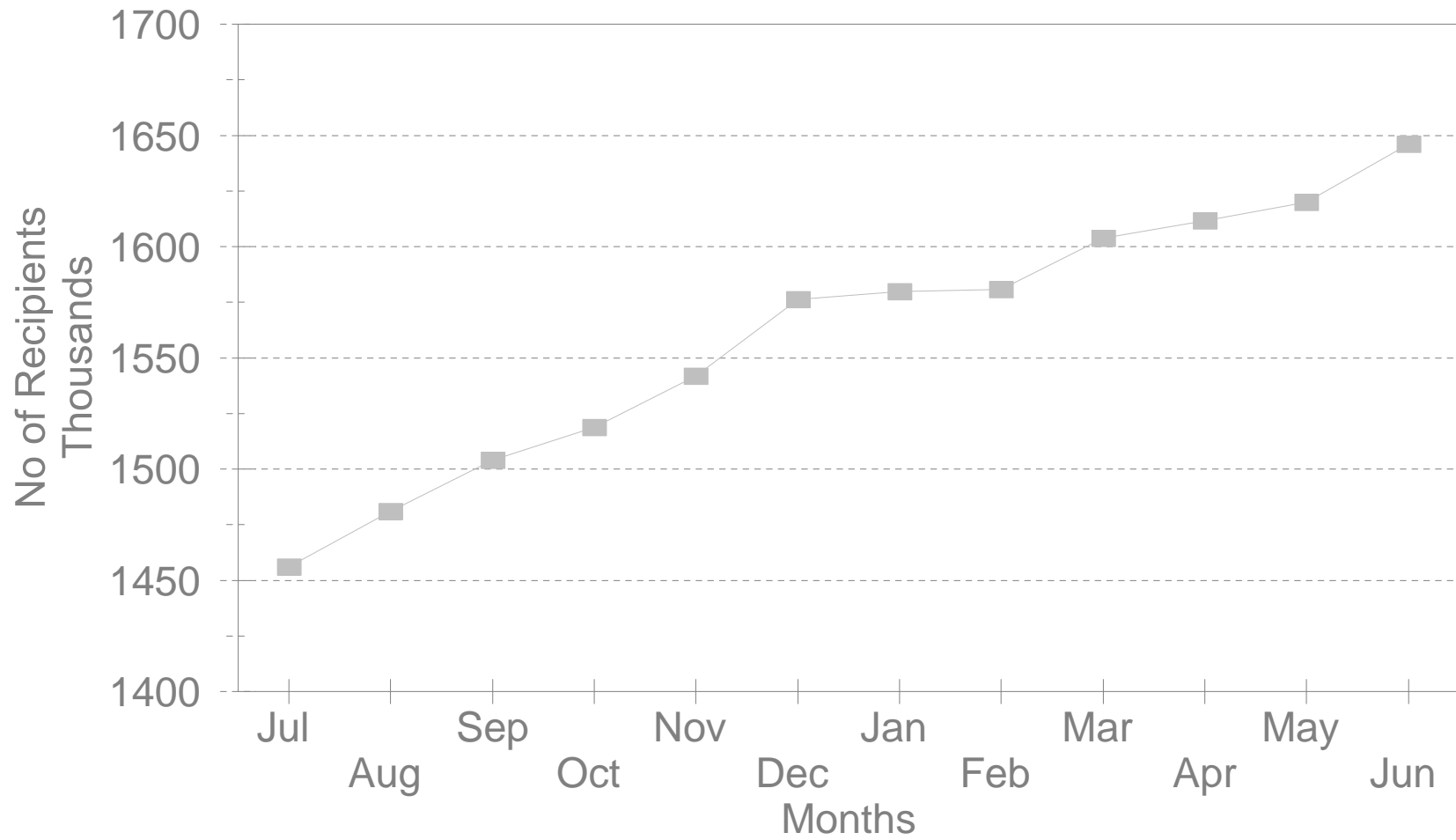
