MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR APRIL 2007

OHIO WORKS FIRST (OWF)

For the month of April 2007, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 77,601; recipients totaled 164,962 and money payments totaled \$24,283,738. The percent change from March 2007 to April 2007 was -0.2% for assistance groups; -0.5% for recipients, and -4.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 74,508 assistance groups; 152,556 recipients, and \$23,014,252 in money payments issued for April 2007. The percent change from March 2007 to April 2007 was -0.1% for assistance groups; -0.3% for recipients, and -4.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,093; recipients, 12,406 and money payments were \$1,269,486. The percent change from March 2007 to April 2007 was -2.0% for assistance groups; -3.0% for recipients and -8.3% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 26,182 children received \$17,403,927 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of April 2007. Included in this total were 6,477 foster care children who received \$9,691,164 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,568 or 9.8% were in foster family homes who received \$1,057,852 and 3,909 or 14.9% children in child care institutions who received \$8,633,313 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 19,705 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,712,763 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$664.73.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of April 2007, there were 13,870 assistance groups; 13,947 recipients, and \$1,768,558 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$126.81. Total DA expenditures for medical services for April 2007 were \$1,726,745. Of this total, \$1,235,879 or 71.6% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$360,229 or 20.9% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 3,449 recipients for an average expenditure of \$500.65 per recipient.

FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES BENEFITS (FNS)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2007 decreased to 1,066,248 by 703 or -0.1% from 1,066,951 persons reported in March 2007. Households increased by 839 or 0.2% over March 2007 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2007 decreased by \$127,832 or -0.1% from \$107,457,412 reported in March 2007 to \$107,329,580 reported in April 2007. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$.05 or -0.1% from those issued in March 2007. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$100.71 reported in March 2007 to \$100.66 reported in April 2007.

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

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups



No of FNS Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


