MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR DECEMBER 2007

OHIO WORKS FIRST (OWF)

For the month of December 2007, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 80,284; recipients totaled 173,254 and money payments totaled \$26,892,023. The percent change from November 2007 to December 2007 was 0.1% for assistance groups; 0.6% for recipients, and 3.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 77,063 assistance groups; 160,029 recipients, and \$25,392,128 in money payments issued for December 2007. The percent change from November 2007 to December 2007 was -0.1% for assistance groups; 0.2% for recipients, and 2.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,221; recipients, 13,225 and money payments we \$1,499,895. The percent change from November 2007 to December 2007 was 4.3% for assistance groups; 5.7% for recipients and 13.0% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of December 2007, there were 15,765 assistance groups; 15,860 recipients, and \$2,135,947 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$134.68. Total DA expenditures for medical services for December 2007 were \$1,100,313. Of this total, \$795,885 or 72.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$216,136 or 19.6% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses wr paid for 2,623 recipients for an average expenditure of \$419.49 per recipient.

FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES BENEFITS (FNS)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2007 increased to 1,127,486 by 14,119 or 1.3% from 1,113,367 persons reported in November 2007. Households increased by 5,663 or 1.1% over November 2007 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2007 increased by \$1,550,589 or 1.3% from \$117,500,130 reported in November 2007 to \$119,050,719 reported in December 2007. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.05 or 0.1% from those issued in November 2007. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$105.54 reported in November 2007 to \$105.59 reported in December 2007.



No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




