Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of February 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 80,044; recipients totaled 172,958 and money payments totaled \$27,004,777. The percent change from January 2008 to February 2008 was 0.2% for assistance groups; 0.1% for recipients, and -0.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 76,479 assistance groups; 158,665 recipients, and \$25,398,308 in money payments issued for February 2008. The percent change from January 2008 to February 2008 was 0.1% for assistance groups; -0.1% for recipients, and -0.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,565; recipients, 14,293 and money payments we \$1,606,469. The percent change from January 2008 to February 2008 was 2.6% for assistance groups; 1.8% for recipients and -0.6% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of February 2008, there were 16,307 assistance groups; 16,404 recipients, and \$2,362,159 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$144.00. Total DA expenditures for medical services for February 2008 were \$1,112,767. Of this total, \$804,605 or 72.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$230,197 or 20.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 2,326 recipients for an average expenditure of \$478.40 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during February 2008 decreased to 1,125,988 by 13,507 or -1.2% from 1,139,495 persons reported in January 2008. Households decreased by 5,084 or -1.0% over January 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during February 2008 decreased by \$1,686,287 or -1.4% from \$121,062,178 reported in January 2008 to \$119,375,891 reported in February 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$ 0.22 or -0.2% from those issued in January 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$106.24 reported in January 2008 to \$106.02 reported in February 2008.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months





DA Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months





Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


