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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for March 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of March 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 79,452; recipients totaled 171,222 and money payments totaled \$26,304,898. The percent change from February 2008 to March 2008 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -1.0% for recipients, and -2.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 75,777 assistance groups; 156,512 recipients, and \$24,682,871 in money payments issued for March 2008. The percent change from February 2008 to March 2008 was -0.9% for assistance groups; -1.4% for recipients, and -2.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,675, recipients, 14,710 and money payments were \$1,622,027. The percent change from February 2008 to March 2008 was 3.1% for assistance groups; 2.9% for recipients and 1.0% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of March 2008, there were 16,671 assistance groups; 16,766 recipients, and \$2,332,649 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$139.13. Total DA expenditures for medical services for March 2008 were \$1,110,887. Of this total, \$817,047 or 73.5% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$220,969 or 19.9% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 2,265 recipients for an average expenditure of \$490.46 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during March 2008 increased to 1,142,480 by 16,492 or 1.5% from 1,125,988 persons reported in February 2008. Households increased by 11,921 or 2.3% over February 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during March 2008 increased by \$2,491,896 or 2.1% from \$119,375,891 reported in February 2008 to \$121,867,787 reported in March 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.65 or 0.6% from those issued in February 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$106.02 reported in February 2008 to \$106.67 reported in March 2008.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months





DA Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months





Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


