## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for April 2008

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of April 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 80,373; recipients totaled 173,597 and money payments totaled \$27,293,325. The percent change from March 2008 to April 2008 was 1.2% for assistance groups; 1.4% for recipients, and 3.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 76,680 assistance groups; 158,911 recipients, and \$25,620,014 in money payments issued for April 2008. The percent change from March 2008 to April 2008 was 1.2% for assistance groups; 1.5% for recipients, and 3.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,693, recipients, 14,686 and money payments were \$1,673,311. The percent change from March 2008 to April 2008 was 0.5% for assistance groups; -0.2% for recipients and 3.2% for money payments.

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of April 2008, there were 17,055 assistance groups; 17,161 recipients, and \$2,572,117 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$149.88. Total DA expenditures for medical services for April 2008 were \$1,275,802. Of this total, \$960,415 or 75.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$234,000 or 18.3% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 2,256 recipients for an average expenditure of \$565.52 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2008 increased to 1,151,969 by 9,489 or 0.8% from 1,142,480 persons reported in March 2008. Households increased by 4,097 or 0.8% over March 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2008 increased by \$1,338,780 or 1.1% from \$121,867,787 reported in March 2008 to \$123,206,567 reported in April 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.28 or 0.3% from those issued in March 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$106.67 reported in March 2008 to \$106.95 reported in April 2008.


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


## No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months








