Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for June 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of June 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 79,255; recipients totaled 170,269 and money payments totaled \$26,452,046. The percent change from May 2008 to June 2008 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -1.1% for recipients, and -1.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 75,728 assistance groups; 156,314 recipients, and \$24,882,359 in money payments issued for June 2008. The percent change from May 2008 to June 2008 was -0.5% for assistance groups; -0.8% for recipients, and -1.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,527, recipients, 13,955 and money payments were \$1,569,687. The percent change from May 2008 to June 2008 was -3.6% for assistance groups; -4.3% for recipients and -4.1% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of June 2008, there were 17,599 assistance groups; 17,693 recipients, and \$2,526,676 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$142.81. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2008 were \$ 912,775. Of this total, \$710,546 or 77.8% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$165,454 or 18.1% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 2,116 recipients for an average expenditure of \$431.37 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2008 increased to 1,169,023 by 9,186 or 0.8% from 1,159,837 persons reported in May 2008. Households increased by 4,277 or 0.8% over May 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2008 increased by \$ 1,097,437 or 0.9% from \$123,341,806 reported in May 2008 to \$124,439,243 reported in June 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.11 or 0.1% from those issued in May 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$106.34 reported in May 2008 to \$106.45 reported in June 2008.



No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months





DA Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months





Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


